Convocation 2007

The Nineteenth Annual Convocation of Goa University was held on Sunday, 14th January 2007 at the Dinanath Mangueshkar Hall, Kala Academy.

His Excellency, Professor Anibal Cavaco Silva, President of the Portuguese Republic was the Chief Guest for the convocation. In his speech he said, 'If global output is increasing we should be able to design policies, both at the national and international levels, which distribute fairly the benefits of economic integration'. Focusing his speech on globalisation, Silva had a word of praise for India calling it "the symbol of the new integrated world and one of the countries where growth has been more impressive over the last two-and-half decades." The President, an economics professor himself, said, "Globalisation is the way of the future, and inspite of the issue it raises, the opportunities that

lie on further integration of markets and economies are enormous and exciting." The Governor, Mr. S.C. Jamir, who is also the Chancellor of the Goa University, conferred the D.Litt degree on the Portuguese President, in the presence of the Chief Minister, Mr. Pratapsing Rane, the Education Minister, Mr. Luizinho Faleiro and the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. P. S. Zacharias. During the convocation, meritorious students and Ph.D. awardees were presented with medals and certificates by Shri S. C. Jamir. Some guests from Portugal also attented the convocation ceremony.

Goa University Distinguished Lecture Series

Goa University organized a talk by Prof. T.V. Paul, Department of Political Science, University of McGill, Canada on 'Globalization and National Security State' recently. The talk was chaired by Prof. V. Shiv Kumar, Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences. Dr Aureliano Fernandes, Head of the Department welcomed the gathering and introduced the speaker.

Prof. Paul provided a brief of his project on the theme which seeks to study the linkages between globalization and character of the national security state that is unfolding. Securing territorial frontiers has been the prime concern of nation states, but the premise is being challenged with opening of borders and rapid flow of economic and political ideas, he opined. Nation States continue to face threats from non conventional sources and human security is becoming a primary concern. There are some countries however which are still caught in the national security mindset, irrespective of globalization, he felt. India is in a paradoxical situation, whereby it is trying to emerge as an economic powerhouse and at the same time develop military capability. It needs to assert its role globally by entering into pragmatic partnerships with both small and bigger nations, he asserted.

Prof. Paul is author of the books: India in the World Order: Searching for Major Power Status; Power versus Prudence: Why Nations Forgo Nuclear Weapons and Asymmetric Conflicts: War Initiation by Weaker Powers.

The lecture was attended by faculty, students, media and members of the public.
