POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE FACULTY BOARD

- 1. To co-ordinate the teaching and research work in the Department assigned to the faculty.
- 2. To co-ordinate the teaching and research work of interdisciplinary nature in the faculty.
- 3. To plan the general time-table of the departments in the faculty and review the arrangements of the space/room for allocation of Lectures/seminar etc among the departments in the faculty.
- 4. To Consider and act on any proposal regarding the welfare of the students in the faculty.
- 5. To consider schemes for the advancement of the standard of teaching and research and to submit proposals in this regard to the Academic Council.
- 6. To remit any matter to a Board of Studies within the purview of the faculty for consideration and report.
- 7. To perform all other functions which may be prescribed by the act, statutes, ordinances and to consider all such maters as may be referred to it by the Executive Council, Academic Council or the Vice-Chancellor.
- 8. To delegate to the Dean or to any other member of the faculty board or to a committee such powers or specific as may be desired.

ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONS

- a) Faculty Board to give priority to:
 - Develop steps for homogeneous working among the departments
 - Launch interdisciplinary/interdepartmental teaching/research programmes.
 - Share space/expensive equipment/facilities among Departments
 - Improve quality of teaching/research pursued (short-term)
- b) Faculty board to do forward planning for new areas/programmes to be launched in its departments (Long-term)
