**ELIGIBILITY**

Candidates who have obtained a Master's Degree by papers securing at least second class with minimum 55% marks (5% relaxation for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently Abled candidates) or equivalent grade and/or by research from Goa University, or from any other University recognized by Goa University, are eligible to register for the M.Phil/Ph.D. Programme.

Scanned copies of a) statement of post Graduation Final Marks (b) Scanned Certificate of Passing NET/SET/JRF examination.

**d. Category Certificate if applicable.**

## **EXEMPTIONS**

A] Candidates who have qualified in the examinations of apex bodies such as CSIR/UGC/NET/JRF/Lectureship, SET/SLET examination of different Indian States/ GATE with a valid certificate, or regular M.Phil. Degree holders admitted on the basis of Entrance Examination and interview shall be exempted from appearing for the Entrance Test. Such candidates shall be eligible to appear for an interview in the concerned Department.

B] Candidates who were successful in the Goa University Ph.D./M.Phil Entrance Test of July/August 2016 shall be exempted from appearing for the Entrance Test. Such candidates shall be eligible to appear for an interview in the concerned Department.

**In both the above cases, the candidates shall submit the online application along with the prescribed fees.**

**[Students who have completed M.Phil by distance mode are not eligible for exemption from the Entrance Test. ]**

## **SCHEME OF EXAMINATION**

**Paper I                      Marks 100                      Duration : 2 hours**

50 objective type questions based on UGC/CSIR/NET paper I Syllabus

**Paper II                      Marks 100                      Duration : 2 hours**

Section A                      Marks 50                      Multiple choice questions (MCQS)

Section B                      Marks 50                      Theoretical/Descriptive Questions

**There shall be internal choice for section B of paper II**

**Syllabus for paper II**

Paper II shall be as per the syllabus for UGC/CSIR/NET examination in the relevant subjects .

## **STANDARD OF PASSING**

Candidates securing minimum of 50 % marks (45% in case of reserved categories ) in each of the papers shall qualify in the Entrance Test and are eligible to appear for the Interview .
