A national level examination, GATE (Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering) is a qualifying examination for admissions to post-graduate programs in Indian institutes of higher education with financial assistance provided by MHRD and other Government agencies. GATE scores are also be used by Public and Private Sector. This examination tests the comprehensive understanding of candidate in post-graduate level subjects in Science. In all 23 papers test the student's knowledge. Large number of questions are to be answered online by keying numerical answers by the candidate using the virtual keypad besides Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ). During this year (2018), five students from M.Sc. Marine Biotechnology and one M.Sc. Biotechnology cleared the GATE examination.
