**NOTIFICATION**

Applicants seeking admission to various Post Graduation Degree Programmes at Goa University and affiliated colleges for the academic year 2018-19 will be accepted through online mode only. Interested candidates are informed to view Goa University website [www.unigoa.ac.in](http://www.unigoa.ac.in) for full details including University Prospectus information. The last date for submission of online application is 04<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

Admissions to the Post Graduate Programmes shall be entirely based on the Goa University Admissions Ranking Test (GU-ART) to be conducted by the Goa University. The marks percentage obtained by the students while graduating would only be used to ascertain the eligibility of candidates to appear for the (GU-ART). The purpose of the (GU-ART) is only to rank the prospective students and not for determination of pass/ fail.

Candidates shall be permitted to apply for a maximum of three subjects/specializations only.

Candidates are requested to note the following details regarding (GU-ART).

1. The (GU-ART) shall be of one paper of 100 marks, for 1 ½ hour duration, containing 50 objective type multiple choice questions of 2 marks each, evaluated with negative marking, where half a mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer.
2. The breakup of 100 marks for the (GU-ART) Question paper shall be as follows:

Section I (least difficult)	- 15 Questions
Section II (difficult)	- 15 Questions
Section III (most difficult)	- 20 Questions

3. In case of candidates who have answered the (GU-ART) and have secured equal marks in the Merit list/(GU-ART) ;
  - (a) Section III scores shall be the first level of tie breaker, followed by Section II and thereafter Section I.
  - (b) In case of tie after first level, Section II scores shall be the second level of tie breaker.
  - (c) In case the tie still exists, the University shall decide the order of merit.
4. The (GU-ART) will be based on the Third Year syllabus of the Degree programme of Goa University in the respective subject /specialisation.
5. Those Programmes which admit candidates from across the disciplines such as M.A. Women's Studies, M.C.A., M.Sc. in Biotechnology, Marine Science, Biochemistry and other such programmes, the test shall be based on general knowledge, analytical ability, logical reasoning and the specific subject syllabus, where applicable, of up to the level of HSSC.
6. A single (GU-ART) shall be conducted for admission to M.Sc. Programme in Marine Microbiology and Microbiology.
7. Candidates seeking admission to the Post Graduate programmes at Goa University and affiliated colleges are requested to appear for the (GU-ART) to be conducted by the Goa University for programmes offered both at the University Departments and affiliated Colleges.
8. The University shall notify consolidated (GU-ART) Results for each programme, based on which the University/ Colleges shall prepare the

merit list of candidates for admission to the respective programmes at the University and affiliated colleges following the Reservation Policy.

9. (GU-ART) for the programmes which are only offered at Colleges such as M.Sc. Food Technology, M.Sc. Pharmaceutical Chemistry, M.A. Psychology, M.A. Wellness Counseling and Master of Social Work will not be conducted at the Goa University. The (GU-ART) shall be conducted by respective Colleges.
