30th Annual Convocation

The 30th Annual Convocation of Goa University has been scheduled on Saturday, 7th July 2018 and the University will have the proud privilege of welcoming Hon'ble President of India, Shri Ramnath Kovind as Chief Guest of the function. Other dignitaries present on the dais will be the Hon'ble, Governor of Goa and Chancellor of Goa University, Dr. Smt. Mridula Sinha and Hon'ble Chief Minister of Goa, Shri. The first Convocation of the Goa University was held on February 25th, 1989, where H.E. Dr. Gopal Singh, Governor of Goa, was Chief Guest for the ceremony and since then, the University has had the honour of having several dignitaries as Chief Guests at the Convocation Ceremony including Hon'ble President of India Dr. A.
