Important Notice

Admission to the three year, six semester, full time course leading to the degree of “Master of Computer Applications” (MCA), is open to any Indian National satisfying all of the following **revised eligibility criteria** for the academic year 2018-19:

1. Graduate in any discipline with at least 55% aggregate marks at the first degree examination (50% for candidates in reserved category - OBC, ST, SC, PH, Ex-servicemen)

Or

Minimum CPI must be 6.00 in the scale of 1 to 10 at the first degree examination (minimum CPI must be 5.5 in the scale of 1 to 10 for candidates in reserved category – OBC, ST, SC, PH, Ex-servicemen)

Or

For any other method of declaration of the result, the equivalent percentage of the above cases will be decided by the university after the applications have been received. The decision of the university is final.

2. Candidate must have taken Mathematics as one of the subjects at HSSCE (10+2) level or at a higher level (documentary proof is essential).

The admission to first year of MCA program for the year 2018-19 (Second Round GU-ART) will be strictly based on the Rank obtained in the Ranking Test conducted by the Department of Computer Science and Technology, Goa University on 20th July 2018 at 2.30pm. [Click here to apply for GU_ART](#).

The reservation of seats under various categories will be as per reservation rules.

Candidates in Merit List who fail to report to the department by above said time will lose their claim to admission and the same seat would be offered to the candidate in the waiting list.
