REPORT ON the Cleanliness Drive and Awareness Programme organised by Directorate of UBA, Goa University in Collaboration with the Village Panchayat, St. Cruz at Cacra Village on 13th July 2018

The cleanliness drive cum awareness programme was organized by the Directorate of UBA, Goa University in Collaboration with the Village Panchayat, St. Cruz at Cacra Village on 13th July 2018 at 10 am in the Cacra Village (one of the five adopted villages under UBA).
