#### ELIGIBILITY

(i) A candidate who has obtained a Master's Degree or a professional Degree declared equivalent to the Master's Degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate, or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed), or an equivalent Degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible to register for the Ph.D. Degree.

(ii) A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, shall be given for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace marks.

(iii) Candidates who have cleared the M.Phil. Course work with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and successfully completed the M.Phil. Degree shall be eligible to proceed to do research work leading to the Ph. D. Degree in the same Institution in an integrated Programme. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent

relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

(iv)The subject of research shall be that which relates to the main branch/ branches of knowledge chosen by the candidate for the post-graduate Degree. However, a candidate wishing to conduct research in a subject of an interdisciplinary character shall also be eligible for registration. The applications of such candidates shall be considered by following the procedure set out under OA-19A.2(v).

(v) Candidates of Goa University whose M.Phil Dissertation has been evaluated and Viva is pending, shall be eligible to apply for the Ph.D. Programme.

(vi) Candidates possessing a Degree considered equivalent to M.Phil. Degree of an Indian Institution, from a Foreign Educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D. Programme.

### **DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED AT THE TIME OF FILLING ONLINE APPLICATION FORM**

1. For students with post graduate degree applying for M.Phil./Ph.D.:  
Self attested copies of a) Statement of Marks, (b) Certificate of Passing post graduation and (c) Category certificate (if applicable); For OBC (non-creamy layer) validity of the certificate is 3 years.
2. For students with M.Phil. degree applying for Ph.D.:  
Self attested copies of a) Statement of Post Graduation Final Marks, (b) Certificate of Passing M. Phil. and (c) Category certificate (if applicable); For OBC (non-creamy layer) validity of the certificate is 3 years.
3. For NET/SET/JRF qualified students applying for M.Phil./Ph.D.:  
Self Attested copies of (a) Statement of Post Graduation final Marks, (b) Certificate of Passing post graduation, (c) Certificate of Passing NET/SET/JRF examination and (d) Category certificate (if applicable); For OBC (non-creamy layer) validity of the certificate is 3 years.

### **EXEMPTION FROM ENTRANCE TEST:**

1. Candidates who have qualified in the examinations of apex bodies such as CSIR-UGC/UGC NET JRF/ lecturership, SET/SLET examination of different Indian States/ GATE with a valid certificate, or regular M.Phil. Degree holders admitted on the basis of Entrance Examination and interview shall be exempted from appearing for the Entrance Test. Such candidates shall be eligible to appear for an interview in the concerned Department.

2. All the candidates who have qualified in the M. Phil/Ph.D. Entrance Test conducted by this University held in the month of July/August 2017
