NOTIFICATION

It is hereby notified that admissions to the Post Graduate Programmes at the **University Departments and Affiliated Colleges** for the **academic year 2019-20** shall be entirely based on the Goa University Admissions Ranking Test (GU-ART) to be conducted by the Goa University. The marks percentage obtained by the students while graduating would only be used to ascertain the eligibility of candidates to appear for the GU-ART. The purpose of the GU-ART is only to rank the prospective students and not for determination of pass/ fail.

Candidates pursuing their Final Year Graduation are eligible to apply.

The Schedule for the GU-ART will be as follows:

GU-ART Round I	–	13/01/2019; 20/01/2019; 27/01/2019; 03/02/2019
GU-ART Round II	–	20/03/2019 [if seats are vacant]
GU-ART Round III	–	10/06/2019 [if seats are vacant]

The First Round of GU-ART will be held **in the colleges offering PG Programmes** on sequential Sundays commencing **13.01.2019**.

Seats shall be allotted to Candidates based on their performance in the First Round of GU-ART. For Programmes offered at both the University as well as the affiliated colleges, Seats shall be allotted through COUNSELLING to be held at the Goa University.

The Second Round of GU-ART will be held **in the University Departments** to fill seats which remain vacant after the First Round of Admissions including Reserved Category seats. **Reserved Category Seats** remaining vacant after the first list of the Second Round will be transferred to the General Category.

Candidates shall be permitted to apply for a maximum of three subjects/specializations only.

Candidates are requested to note the following details regarding GU-ART.

1. The GU-ART shall be of one paper of 100 marks, for 1 ½ hour duration, containing 50 objective type multiple choice questions of 2 marks each, evaluated with negative marking, where half a mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer.

2. The breakup of 100 marks for the GU-ART Question paper shall be as follows:

Section I (least difficult)	- 15 Questions
Section II (difficult)	- 15 Questions
Section III (most difficult)	- 20 Questions
3. In case of candidates who have answered the GU-ART and have secured equal marks in the ranking list :
 - a) Section III scores shall be the first level of tie breaker.
 - b) In case of tie after first level, Section II scores shall be the second level of tie breaker.
 - c) In case the tie still exists, the University shall decide the order of merit.
4. The GU-ART will be based on the Semester I-IV syllabus of the Degree programme of Goa University in the respective subject /specialization. Those Programmes which admit candidates from across the disciplines such as M.A. International Relations, Women's Studies, M.C.A., M.Sc. in Biotechnology, Marine Science, Biochemistry and other such programmes, the test shall be based on general knowledge, analytical ability, logical reasoning and the specific subject syllabus, where applicable.
5. Details of the Syllabus for the GU-ART in the various subjects is available on the Goa University website www.unigoa.ac.in
6. A single Ranking Test shall be conducted for admission to M.Sc. Programme in Marine Microbiology and Microbiology.

Applicants seeking admission to various Post Graduation Degree Programmes at Goa University and affiliated colleges for the academic year 2019-20 will be accepted through online mode only. Interested candidates are informed to visit Goa University website www.unigoa.ac.in for details.
