In the event of tie, such cases will be resolved by applying following criteria in the order one after another, till the tie is resolved:

- (iii) Date of Birth, i.e. older candidate is placed higher in the merit list

The selection of the shortlisted candidates will be subject to the condition that they fulfil the eligibility criteria as per the Information Brochure of the advertisement.

You are required to remain present for the written test sharp at 10.00 a.m. at your respective venue viz block and room alongwith the hall ticket as per instructions given therein. Further, skill test will be taken after the written test.

No interview will be conducted for the final selection of the candidates. The performance in the written and skill test will be basis for the merit list and final selection.

Section-A

Scheme of examination:

Written test will be conducted for 50 marks. It consists of two Sections viz Section-A and Section-B. Section A will consist of Konkani Language of 10 Marks for which candidates have to secure 40% for short listing.

Section B will consist as follows.

1. General awareness on automobile maintenance – 10 marks.
2. Science at SSC level (class 10th) (as per the enclosed syllabus)- 15 marks.
3. Maths at SSC (class 10th) level (as per the enclosed syllabus) – 15 marks.

Each Correct answer will carry 1 mark and wrong answer will carry -0.25 marks.
