NOTIFICATION - PG ADMISSIONS 2019-20 : ROUND-II

Goa University Admissions Ranking Test (GU-ART) Round-I for admission to various Post Graduation Degree Programmes at Goa University and its Affiliated Colleges offering Post Graduation programmes for the academic year 2019-2020 was held on 27th January 2019, 3rd February 2019 and 10th February 2019.

Based on the GU-ART Round-I, Departments on University Campus and affiliated colleges have admitted selected candidates as per the ranking for various Programmes. After verifying Provisional Merit list, it is observed that some Departments and Affiliated Colleges still have some vacant seats.

As seats are still available, especially under the Reserved Categories, the University has decided to invite applications and conduct 2^{nd} round of GU-ART for admission to various Post Graduation Degree Programmes at Goa University and affiliated colleges for the academic year 2019-20 through online mode only. Interested candidates are informed to visit Goa University website <u>www.unigoa.ac.in</u> for details.

Eligibility:

Admissions to the Post Graduate Programmes shall be entirely based on the **Goa University Admissions Ranking Test (GU-ART)**. The marks percentage obtained by the students while graduating would only be used to ascertain the eligibility of candidates for the Programme. The purpose of the GU-ART is only to rank the prospective students and not for determination of pass/ fail.

Candidates who have completed their Graduation or are in their Final Year of Graduation are eligible to apply.

Selected candidates who are in the Final Year of Graduation shall be granted Provisional Admission. Their admission will be confirmed after the results are declared based on the eligibility. In case a candidate fails to clear the Graduation Examination, the admission shall be cancelled and the fees shall be refunded.

Candidate applying for the GU-ART for the B.Ed. Programme are informed that: Only Goan Domicile candidates are eligible to apply for the B.Ed. programme.

The following <u>Eligibility</u> criteria are applicable for candidates applying for the <u>MCA Programme</u>: Admission to three-year, six semester, full time course leading to the degree of Master of Computer Applications, is open to any graduate with first degree in any discipline and securing at least 55% (50% in case of SC & OBC) aggregate marks at first degree examination.

The candidate must have opted Mathematics as one of the subjects at the HSSC (10+2) level or at a higher level.

For eligibility under change in Faculty / Subject please refer Annexure I.

GU-ART Coverage:

- 1. Please refer <u>Annexure II</u> for tentative fees for Academic year 2019-20 (For Programmes offered at Goa University Campus).
- 2. Admissions to the B.Ed Programme for the academic year 2019-20 offered at the affiliated colleges will also be based on GU-ART along with the other eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Directorate of Higher Education [DHE], Government of Goa.

 - M.B.A. (Dept of Management Studies)
 - I-M.B.A. (Dept of Management Studies)
 - Marine Biotechnology

Application Process:

The <u>LAST DATE</u> for submission of application is <u>Thursday 23rd May 2019 upto 5:00 P.M.</u>

Candidates are advised to use GUMS admissions portal on a Laptop or a Desktop computer and preferably <u>avoid using on Mobile phone or Tablet</u>.

Application Fees:

- INR 600 per subject/specialization [Except MCA & MBA(FS)];
- INR 300 in case of SC/ST of Goa [Except MCA & MBA(FS)];
- INR 1,000/- for MCA & MBA(FS), INR 500 in case of SC/ST of Goa
- No fees to be charged from differently abled candidates;
- GU-ART Fees will be accepted online on GUMS portal only.
- Candidates are also advised to preferably use only VISA, MasterCard and Maestro Cards while making online payments. **DO NOT USE RUPAY DEBIT OR CREDIT CARDS**

<u>GU-ART</u>: Candidates are requested to note the following details regarding the GU-ART-Round-II.

Candidates shall be permitted to apply for a maximum of three subjects/specializations only for the PG Programmes.

1. The GU-ART shall be of one paper of 100 marks, containing 50 objective type Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) of 2 marks each. There shall be negative marking, where half a mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer. No marks will be deducted for unanswered questions. The duration of the GU-ART will be of 90 minutes.

- 2. Candidate who are Applying for more than one programme are required to use the same login details.
- 3. No changes will be entertained after the online submission of application.
- 4. The breakup of 100 marks for the GU-ART Question paper shall be as follows:
 - a. Section I (Least difficult) 15 Questions
 - b. Section II (Difficult) 15 Questions
 - c. Section III (Most difficult) 20 Questions
- 5. In case of candidates who have answered the GU-ART and have secured equal marks in the ranking list:
 - Section III scores shall be the first level of tie breaker.
 - In case of tie after first level, Section II scores shall be the second level of tie breaker.
 - In case the tie still exists, the University shall decide the order of merit.
- The GU-ART syllabus will be based on the Semester I-IV syllabus of the Degree programme of Goa University in the respective subject/specialization. - Those Programmes which admit candidates from across the disciplines such as M.A. Women's Studies, M.C.A., M.Sc. in Biotechnology, Marine Science, Biochemistry and other such programmes, the test shall be based on general knowledge, analytical ability, logical reasoning and the specific subject syllabus, where applicable. - 8. A single GU-ART shall be conducted for admission to M.Sc. Programme in Marine Microbiology and Microbiology.
- 9. A single GU-ART shall be conducted for admission to Msc Zoology and Post Graduate Diploma in Medical Laboratory Techniques.
- **10.** Candidates who have already answered GU-ART Round I of a particular programme are not required to answer again.
- 11. Please note that Candidates answering the GU-ART Round II shall be ranked after the previous Round candidates.

Example: If 100 candidates apply for Round I, all 100 will be assigned a rank based on the marks scored. For Round II, candidates shall be ranked from 101 onwards. The candidate scoring highest marks at GU-ART Round II will be ranked 101.

GU-ART Schedule:

1. GU-ART Round II, will be conducted at Goa University Campus in the 1st week of June, 2019 followed by Counselling.

Admission Process:

- 1. The results of GU-ART Round II will be declared on the University Website by 2nd week of June, 2019.
- 2. After the Results of Round II are declared, for Programmes offered only at the University Departments, seats shall be allotted to candidates based on their performance in the GU-ART Round I and II.
- 3. For Programmes offered at both the University as well as the affiliated colleges, Seats shall be allotted through COUNSELLING which will be held at the Goa University Campus. Here the rankers shall confirm their course selection (In case candidates have applied for GU-ART in multiple subjects/specialization) and selection of seat at University Department or at affiliated college.
- 4. Candidates who are Selected/Allotted seats during the Counselling shall be required to pay the fees and confirm their admission for the Programme.
- 5. Reserved Category Seats remaining vacant after the first list of the Second Round will be transferred to the General Category.
- 6. Candidates who have selected a seat during first round of Admission (including at Counselling) and wishes to transfer their seat, will be able to do so at the time of 2nd Admission Round to be held after 2nd GU-ART to be held in June 2019.

RESERVATION UNDER VARIOUS CATEGORIES

As per the revised guidelines of the UGC, reservation of seats in case of Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) candidates for admission to various programmes of study in the University shall be on the basis of the reservation policy of the State Government.

2% of seats in each of the Post Graduate programmes of study, subject to a **minimum of one** seat, shall be reserved for candidates belonging to SC category.

12% of seats in each of the Post Graduate programmes of study, subject to a **minimum of one** seat, shall be reserved for candidates belonging to **ST** category. Candidates applying for admission under these categories shall be required to submit a certificate to that effect issued by the officer of the rank of the Deputy Collector or above.

27% of total seats, subject to a **minimum of two seats**, for admission to various programmes of study, shall be reserved for candidates belonging to other backward classes (**OBC**) of the State of Goa as per the directives of the State Government. Candidates applying under this category shall be required to submit a certificate issued to that effect by the officer of the rank of the Mamlatdar or above.

5% of total seats, subject to minimum one seat for admission to various programmes of study shall be reserved for **differently abled** candidates (as per State Government directives).

10% of seats, subject to a maximum of two seats and a minimum of one seat in each programme of study, except the MCA & MBA programmes of study, shall be made available for candidates of other Universities.

1% of total seats shall be reserved for Children of Ex- servicemen.

Seats falling vacant under any of the above reserved categories shall be filled from the general category candidates with the approval of the Vice Chancellor.

15% of seats, over and above the allotted number of seats, shall be reserved as supernumerary seats for the overseas candidates, who are eligible for admission and are recommended by Govt. of India under scholarship from Govt. of India or under exchange programme (ICCR Programme). These seats shall be filled in accordance with the UGC guidelines. Out of the 15% supernumerary seats, one seat in each program will be reserved for Kashmiri Migrants (KM) as per directives of the UGC.

Percentage of seats mentioned above is subject to change depending upon directives of the State Government.

REFUND OF COURSE FEES

a) If a student chooses to withdraw from the programme of study in which he/she is enrolled, the following four-tier system shall be followed for the refund of fees remitted by him/her.

Sr. No.	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to the College/University	% of refund of Aggregate fees*
1.	15 days before the formally notified last date of admission.	100%
2.	Not more than 15 days after the formally notified last date of admission.	80%
3.	More than 15 days but less than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission.	50%
4.	More than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission.	00%

* (Inclusive of tuition fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of Caution Deposit and Security Deposit)

- b) In case of (1) in the table above, 10% of the aggregate fees shall be deducted as processing charges from the refundable amount.
- c) Fees shall be refunded to an eligible student within fifteen days from the date of receiving a written application from him/her in this regard.
- d) The fees of students who have already been admitted to a programme of the University and have paid the fees and are subsequently admitted to another programme shall have to pay the fees for the final admission and claim the refund of fees paid earlier, in which case no administrative charges shall be deducted from fees paid earlier by the student.

However, if the fees payable for the both the programmes are the same, the fees paid earlier shall be transferred to the final programme where admission is sought.

e) All other cases of the refund of the fees will be decided on case to case basis on its merit.

ANNEXURE I

CHANGE OF FACULTY /SUBJECT

Candidates who have passed Bachelor's degree examination of this University or any other recognized University and secured at least 40% of the aggregate marks may seek admission to the Master's Degree Programme in a subject in which they have not obtained the Bachelor's degree with a minimum of three units. Similarly, candidates passing out the Bachelor's Degree of this University or of any other recognized University in a Faculty other than the Faculty under which admission is sought, with at least 40% of the aggregate marks may also seek admission to the Master's Degree Programme of study of this University. Both these types of candidates will have to apply to the Registrar, in the prescribed form, on or before the date specified in the University Notification/ Prospectus for such change of subject or faculty.

Candidates desirous to be admitted under the scheme of Change of Faculty/Subject for admission to the Master's Degree course shall appear for the Ranking Test in the concerned subject.

Under the scheme of Change of Faculty/Subject, the candidates who have answered the Ranking Test shall be considered eligible for admission to the Master's Degree Programme in the concerned subject, against the vacant seats available, if any, after students from the merit lists are given admission.

Under the scheme of Change of Faculty/Subject, up to two seats may be made available as supernumerary with the approval of Vice-Chancellor, if no vacant seats are available for the qualified candidates and if the normal supernumerary seats are not filled.
