Admission to PG Programmes:

Admission to various Post Graduation Programmes at Goa University and its Affiliated Colleges for the academic year 2019-2020 is conducted through Goa University Admissions Ranking Test (GU-ART).

Based on the GU-ART Round-I, Round-II, and Round III, School/Departments on University Campus and affiliated colleges have admitted selected candidates as per the ranking for various Programmes. After verifying Provisional selection lists, it is observed that some School/Departments and Affiliated Colleges still have some vacant seats.

In view of this the University invites application for GU-ART III/ Round IV for admission to the following Programmes at Goa University and affiliated colleges for Admission to the academic year 2019-20.

Application process is through online mode only. Interested candidates may visit Goa University website www.unigoa.ac.in for details.

Eligibility:

Admissions to the Post Graduate Programmes shall be entirely based on the **Goa University Admissions Ranking Test (GU-ART)**. The marks percentage obtained by the students while graduating would only be used to ascertain the eligibility of candidates for the Programme. The purpose of the GU-ART is only to rank the prospective students and not for determination of pass/ fail.

Candidates who have completed their Graduation or are in their Final Year of Graduation are eligible to apply.

Selected candidates who are in the Final Year of Graduation shall be granted Provisional Admission. Their admission will be confirmed after the results are declared based on the eligibility. In case a candidate fails to clear the Graduation Examination, the admission shall be cancelled and the fees shall be refunded.

GU-ART Coverage:

Application Process:

The LAST DATE for online application is Wednesday 3rd July 2019.

GU-ART Schedule: GU-ART Round III & IV will be conducted at Goa University Campus on 5th July, 2019.

Detailed schedule and admit card will be available on University website on 4th July 2019

Candidates are advised to use GUMS admissions portal on a Laptop or a Desktop computer and preferably avoid using on Mobile phone or Tablet.

Application Fees:

- INR 600 per subject/specialization
- INR 300 in case of SC/ST of Goa
- No fees to be charged from differently abled candidates;
- GU-ART Fees will be accepted online on GUMS portal only.
- Candidates are also advised to preferably use only VISA, MasterCard and Maestro Cards while making online payments. **DO NOT USE RUPAY DEBIT OR CREDIT CARDS**

Important Points to note:

Candidates shall be permitted to apply for a maximum of three subjects/specializations only for the PG Programmes.

1. The GU-ART shall be of one paper of 100 marks, containing 50 objective type Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) of 2 marks each. There shall be negative marking, where half a mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer. No marks will be deducted for unanswered questions. The duration of the GU-ART will be of 90 minutes.
2. **Candidate who are Applying for more than one programme are required to use the same login details.**
3. **No changes will be entertained after the online submission of application.**
4. The breakup of 100 marks for the GU-ART Question paper shall be as follows:
 - a. Section I (Least difficult) - 15 Questions
 - b. Section II (Difficult) - 15 Questions
 - c. Section III (Most difficult) - 20 Questions
5. In case of candidates who have answered the GU-ART and have secured equal marks in the ranking list:
 - Section III scores shall be the first level of tie breaker.
 - In case of tie after first level, Section II scores shall be the second level of tie breaker.
 - In case the tie still exists, the University shall decide the order of merit.
6. The GU-ART syllabus will be based on the Semester I-IV syllabus of the Degree programme of Goa University in the respective subject/specialization. The GU-ART syllabus of respective programmes is uploaded on the University website. Link: <https://www.unigoa.ac.in/a/pg-admissions-201920-guart-pgbed.html>
7. Those Programmes which admit candidates from across the disciplines such as M.A. Women's Studies, M.C.A., M.Sc. in Biotechnology, Marine Science, Biochemistry and other such programmes, the test shall be based on general knowledge, analytical ability, logical reasoning and the specific subject syllabus, where applicable. 8. **Candidates who have already answered GU-ART Round I, Round II and Round III of a particular programme are not required to answer again.**
9. **Please note that Candidates answering the GU-ART Round shall be ranked after the previous Round candidates.**

Example: If 100 candidates apply for Round I, all 100 will be assigned a rank based on the marks scored. For Round II, candidates shall be ranked from 101 onwards. The candidate scoring highest marks at GU-ART Round II will be ranked 101.
10. All vacant reserved seats are converted to General category after second GU-ART Round.

Admission Process:

1. After the Results of Round III are declared, for Programmes offered only at the University Departments, seats shall be allotted to candidates based on their performance in the GU-ART.

REFUND OF COURSE FEES

- a) If a student chooses to withdraw from the programme of study in which he/she is enrolled, the following four-tier system shall be followed for the refund of fees remitted by him/her.

Sr. No.	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to the College/University	% of refund of Aggregate fees*
1.	15 days before the formally notified last date of admission.	100%
2.	Not more than 15 days after the formally notified last date of admission.	80%
3.	More than 15 days but less than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission.	50%
4.	More than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission.	00%

* (Inclusive of tuition fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of Caution Deposit and Security Deposit)

- b) In case of (1) in the table above, 10% of the aggregate fees shall be deducted as processing charges from the refundable amount.
- c) Fees shall be refunded to an eligible student within fifteen days from the date of receiving a written application from him/her in this regard.
- d) The fees of students who have already been admitted to a programme of the University and have paid the fees and are subsequently admitted to another programme shall have to pay the fees for the final admission and claim the refund of fees paid earlier, in which case no administrative charges shall be deducted from fees paid earlier by the student.

However, if the fees payable for the both the programmes are the same, the fees paid earlier shall be transferred to the final programme where admission is sought.

- e) All other cases of the refund of the fees will be decided on case to case basis on its merit.

ANNEXURE I

CHANGE OF FACULTY /SUBJECT

Candidates who have passed Bachelor's degree examination of this University or any other recognized University and secured at least 40% of the aggregate marks may seek admission to the Master's Degree Programme in a subject in which they have not obtained the Bachelor's degree with a minimum of three units. Similarly, candidates passing out the Bachelor's Degree of this University or of any other recognized University in a Faculty other than the Faculty under which admission is sought, with at least 40% of the aggregate marks may also seek admission to the Master's Degree Programme of study of this University. Both these types of candidates will have to apply to the Registrar, in the prescribed form, on or before the date specified in the University Notification/ Prospectus for such change of subject or faculty.

Candidates desirous to be admitted under the scheme of Change of Faculty/Subject for admission to the Master's Degree course shall appear for the Ranking Test in the concerned subject.

Under the scheme of Change of Faculty/Subject, the candidates who have answered the Ranking Test shall be considered eligible for admission to the Master's Degree Programme in the concerned subject, against the vacant seats available, if any, after students from the merit lists are given admission.

Under the scheme of Change of Faculty/Subject, up to two seats may be made available as supernumerary with the approval of Vice-Chancellor, if no vacant seats are available for the qualified candidates and if the normal supernumerary seats are not filled.
