FINAL COUNSELLING FOR PG ADMISSIONS 2019-20 ROUND IV- 9th July 2019

Guidelines to Candidates

Important Points:

1. Counseling Round is only for Candidates who have answered GU-ART Round I/Round II/Round III/Round IV.
2. Candidates are required to report by 10.30 AM to respective venue as indicated in [Annexure I](#). **Counseling will start at 11.00 AM.**
3. No proxy of candidate shall be permitted. No parents / guardians will be permitted in the Spot Admission Hall unless approved by the University Authorities.
4. All candidates are requested to carry copies of their Marksheet, receipt of Seat confirmation fees (paid if any). Candidates selected at the University will be enrolled after the Counseling round if they are fulfilling all the eligibility criteria.
5. All candidates who will be selected on 9th July 2019 may note that the Last date for verification of documents is 10-07-2019 by 4.00 pm and last date of payment of fees online is 11-06-2019, failing which the seat allotted shall be forfeited.
6. All such candidates are required to submit the proof of payment of fees to their respective the University Department/ School by 11.00AM 12th July 2019.
7. All Candidates are required to wait till the end of the counseling process. As any vacancy arising during the counseling will be offered to a candidate who has a better rank, such a candidate's absence during the counseling would lead to forgoing of that particular seat(s).
8. In case any vacancies remain after Final Counseling scheduled on 9th July 2019, the School/Department of University and affiliated Colleges shall fill it on 12th July 2019 after 11.30 AM on based on the order of Rank and first come first serve basis. Last date to complete all admission formalities is 12th July 2019.

Guidelines

- a. Selected candidates under Counseling Round IV (to be held on 9th July 2019) who have not cleared all the qualifying semesters of a degree are to be offered provisional admission, and such candidates are required to pay Rs. 5,000/-. The concerned University Departments/School are required to provide the names of such candidates to Academic PG section through email latest by 13th July 2019 so as to enable the payment link.
Such Candidates selected at Colleges are required to pay the seat confirmation fees of Rs. 5,000/- at the respective college.
- b. If such a candidate fails to clear the backlog of the qualifying examination, s/he shall be ineligible to continue the Programme, and the seat shall be forfeited and the Rs. 5,000/- paid by them shall be refunded.
- c. Vacancies arising under the reserved category due to transfer/withdrawal/any other reason to be offered to the aspiring candidates of the same reserved category. If no reserved category candidates are available, then these seats are to be opened and filled from the General Category based on the order of Rank.
- d. Other University category candidates who are selected for PG admissions but are awaiting their graduation results are to be given time till 30.9.2019 to submit their original VI semester/years mark sheets and are required to pass/qualify all the semesters/years. An Undertaking to be taken from the candidates stating that the admission granted is provisional and the same will be withdrawn if the candidate does not provide proof of qualification/eligibility by 30.9.2019.
