Focus of the research is to mainly study and document diversity of Herpetofauna through detailed taxonomy (Scale count, morphometric analysis etc) and phylogenetic study to support the hypothesis. Project is funded by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF), New Delhi, Government of India.

Primary aim of the project is to add hitherto unknown information's on diversity and distribution of reptiles and Amphibians of the region and to increase the conservation value towards better habitat management. Study will also initiate conservation awareness among fringe village areas. Besides acting as conservation reference for Goa the project will likely to contribute in filling up the lacuna in herpetological knowledge.

The key output of this project will be to develop a comprehensive Herpetofaunal database that can act as a resource for management and generation of widespread awareness among various section of society. Project is focused on application of morphological, bioacoustics and molecular approaches to studies of taxonomic diversity, phylogenetic relationships and historical biogeography of amphibians and reptiles in the state of Goa, Maharashtra and Karnataka.
