## CIRCULAR

In accordance with the Special Ordinance OS-1 and in partial modification to Circular No. GU/Academic (Colg.)/2020/445 dated 15-05-2020, the University has decided not to hold Semester End Examinations (SEE) for the Second, Fourth and Sixth Semester regular students of the **B.Pharm. Programmes** offered at the Affiliated Colleges of Pharmacy for the current academic year 2019-20.

The students of Second and Fourth Semester shall be graded based on the marks scored by them in the Internal Test (Sessional Examination) during the current Semester. The best of the performance in two Internal Tests shall be considered.

In the case of Semester Six, the performance in one Internal Test (as per ordinance OC -15/15A) will be considered for calculating the grade.

No student shall be detained from moving to the next Semester. However, students who fail after applying the above grading scheme shall have to pass the Examination for the course(s) in which s/he has failed, whenever the Examination is held next.

- a. Such students shall also have an opportunity to improve their grades by appearing for the current Semester course(s) in the succeeding Semester Examinations or as per the provisions of Special Ordinance OS-1.7.
- b. The performance of students appearing for improvement of grades shall not be considered as an additional attempt.

Final Year Examinations (Semester Eight) and Repeat Examinations of lower Semesters shall be conducted from  $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$  July 2020 onwards.

In the event that Regulations/Guidelines are subsequently issued by the Pharmacy Council of India, such Regulations/Guidelines shall supersede the contents of this circular.

Principals of Affiliated Colleges of Pharmacy are requested to bring the contents of this circular to the notice of all concerned.
