## CIRCULAR

In accordance with the Special Ordinance OS-1, and further to Circular No. GU/ Academic-PG/Circular/2020/488 dated 05-05-2020; the University has decided to extend the second Term for the academic year 2019-20 to  $14^{\rm th}$  August 2020.

The University has further decided not to hold Semester End Assessment (SEA) for the lower Semester students of <u>all PG Programmes of General Education</u> offered at the University campus and at the Affiliated Colleges for the current academic year 2019-20 including the Integrated M.B.A. (Hospitality, Travel & Tourism) Programme offered at the Goa Business School and Integrated Master of Commerce Programme offered at S. S. Dempo College of Commerce & Economics, Cujira, Bambolim, Goa.

All the above students shall be graded based on the marks scored by them in the Intra Semester Assessment (ISA) during the current Semester.

Regular/Repeat Examinations of the Final Year Examination and Repeat Examinations of lower Semesters of all PG Programmes of General Education shall be conducted in **online mode** from 3rd August 2020 onwards. Detailed Guidelines for conduct of Online Examination shall be issued subsequently.

No student shall be detained from moving to the next Semester. However, students who fail after applying the above grading scheme shall have to pass the Examination for the course(s) in which s/he has failed, whenever the Examination is held next.

- a. Such students shall also have an opportunity to improve their grades by appearing for the current Semester course(s) in the succeeding Semester Examinations or as per the provisions of special Ordinance OS-1.7.
- b. The performance of students appearing for improvement of grades shall not be considered as an additional attempt.

Deans of Schools/Faculties, Vice-Deans of Schools, Heads of University Teaching Departments and Principals of affiliated colleges offering PG Programmes of General Education are requested to take note of the same and bring the contents of the Circular to the notice of all concerned.
