Modalities of the Course:

1. All the Presiding Officers/Polling Officers must register for the course through google form link <https://forms.gle/EWskFejb5ccaxCiSA> by **14th January 2022**. 3. On **20th January 2022, by 11.am.**, an objective type test will be sent to all the participants through a google link, which they have to answer the same day by **5 P.M.**
