<b><i>Inspiring and motivating youth</i></b>	<p>An <b>International Coastal Cleanup Day Program</b> was organized on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2021 by the <b>School of Earth, Ocean and Atmospheric Sciences</b>, Goa University in collaboration with the <b>National Centre for Coastal Research</b>, Ministry of Earth Sciences, Chennai. This initiative was part of the Ocean Conservancy, Washington and <i>Swaccha Sagar</i> Campaign, India. Miramar Beach, opposite Goa Science Centre, was selected for this event. Around 60 students and 40 teaching and non-teaching staff participated in this program. All the participants were provided with a sanitizer, face masks, gloves and T-shirts. A total of 535 kg of marine debris was collected from the stretch of 500 m which majorly included plastic, rubber, metals, ropes and glass. After the collection and segregation of this marine debris, an awareness campaign was organized. This also includes the potential for co-culture and/or IMTA Integrated MultiTrophic Aquaculture. The aim of this workshop will be to look for possible collaborative projects between Indian and German institutes and the aquaculture industries. There is a huge demand for seafood in the global market as well as in India. The workshop will look for an alternative for mussel/oyster/ Seaweeds production to meet the market demands.
