<p>Efforts to include vocational education and training in the University system</p>	<p>Goa University has started the Marine Farming Activities from the year 2020. In this year 2021 it has been included as a part of and one among the seven themes of the newly constituted Social Entrepreneurship, Swachhata and Rural Engagement Cell (SES-REC) which will be coordinating the activities that will be carried out by our Swachh Bharat Student Internship(SBSI) Interns from Goa University as well from the colleges affiliated to Goa University. The SBSI Course will be monitored by the Directorate of UBA during the period from January 2022 to April/May 2022. The Marine Farming sub-committee looks after the outreach activities and conducts the Marine Farming awareness as well as training programs in villages of Goa mainly in adopted villages of Goa University. The aim of the committee is to educate people, making them aware of the opportunities towards self-employment and entrepreneurship through Marine Farming. Goa is blessed with a long coastline and driven by the tourism industry has huge potential for marine farming. Green mussel farming has been initiated in the Madkai village and Santa Cruz village. Under the marine farming program Dr. Lata Gawade (Chair-person- SES-REC- Marine Farming, sub-committee) attended a short training on seaweed culturing and farming) at Mandapam-Madurai, Tamil Nadu. Dr. Lata wishes to start a new venture i.e. Seaweed farming in Goa through the Marine Farming program of Goa University. Her research proposal on “marine farming – an opportunity towards self-employment, entrepreneurship and rural development” got selected for the Indo-German bilateral funding. Through this funding, Dr. Lata will be conducting a conference in Bremen-Germany in April-2022. Expert scientists, professors, and industry persons from various different Institutes/Universities and Industries from India and Germany will be part of this conference that aims at Indo-German bilateral research project.
