

Prof. Ramesh Pai, the resource person begin the session by briefing about the LaTex Software, its core aspects and uses and encouraged audience to take a keen interest in using LaTex editor for research work processing for good journals. The session was graced by a responsive audience who were very interactive, they were practising on their laptop side by side as resource person was showing it and they asked plenty of questions to the speakers and got their queries resolved.

On 15<sup>th</sup> June, the resource person took a charge of the session at 10.00 am and explained, showed us the various codes we need to take care of while preparing research paper in Latex format by giving examples of various research papers which were in his Archive. The best thing is, he also showed how to use the existing template. LaTex is a code based software, he demonstrated us step by step how do I start functioning in Overleaf LaTex editor and how do I prepare a good paper in LaTex format. For instance he explained how to insert codes for abstract preparation, author details, introduction, references, figures etc. Ultimately he encouraged the participants to keep practicing in LateX editor to grow good number of research papers according to various journal style and the sessions ended with answering various queries of the participants. After the sessions, the Dean of Goa Business School presented a token of gratitude to the resource person and the FDP winded up with a positive note and an overwhelming response and appreciation by everyone who attended it.
