

**NOTIFICATION****GOA UNIVERSITY - ADMISSIONS RANKING TEST (GU-ART) 2022-23 Round IV**

Goa University Admissions Ranking Test (GU-ART) Round-I, Round-II & Round-III for admission to various Post Graduation Degree Programmes offered at Goa University and its Affiliated Colleges offering Post Graduation Programmes for the academic year 2022-23 was held earlier this year. Based on the GU-ART Round-III, selected candidates have confirmed their seats as per the Ranking for various Programmes. As seats are still available, the University has decided to invite applications and conduct the Fourth Round of GU-ART.

Applications for admission to PG Programmes shall be accepted through the online mode latest by 7th September 2022. 6.00 P.M. Interested candidates are informed to visit Goa University website www.unigoa.ac.in for details.

Candidates who have already answered GU-ART 2022-23 Round I, Round II & Round III for a particular programme are not required to apply again.

A. GU-ART Coverage:

- Admission to the Post Graduate Programmes shall be based on GU-ART. For list of Programmes offered at the University Schools and Affiliated Colleges are as under:

B. Eligibility:

Admissions to the Post Graduate Programmes shall be entirely based on the **Goa University - Admissions Ranking Test (GU-ART)**. The marks/percentage obtained by the candidate while graduating would only be used to ascertain the eligibility of candidates for the Programme. The purpose of the GU-ART is only to rank the prospective candidates and not for determination of pass/ fail.

Candidates who are in their Final Year of Graduation are also eligible to apply.

Selected candidates who are in the Final Year of Graduation shall be granted Provisional Admission. Their admission shall be confirmed after the results are declared based on the eligibility. In case a candidate fails to clear the Graduation Examination, the admission shall stand cancelled and the fees shall be refunded.

The Change of Discipline Test shall NOT be conducted for Round IV.

C. Filling up of the Online Application Form:

- a) The **LAST DATE** for submission of applications is **7th September 2022**.
- b) Candidates are advised in their own interest to apply online much before the closing date and not wait till the last date for applying/payment of application fee to avoid the possibility of disconnection/inability/ failure to log on to the website on account of heavy load on the website.
- c) Goa University does not assume any responsibility to candidates in case they are unable to submit their application by the last date on account of the aforesaid reasons or for any other reason beyond the control of the University.
- d) Printout of the application form is **NOT REQUIRED to be submitted to the University.**

Application Fees (To be paid online through GUMS portal only):

- INR 600 per subject/specialization.
- INR 300 in case of SC/ST of Goa.*
- No fees shall be charged from Persons with Disability.

*Candidates applying for admission under these categories shall be required to submit a certificate to that effect issued by the Officer of the rank of the Deputy Collector or any other authorized Officer as notified by the Government of Goa.

Submission of Preferences(Refer Notification final admission Round 2022-23)

Candidates applying for the following programmes which are offered at multiple Institutions/ locations are required to fill a separate [Google Form](#) (Online). Submit their preferences of Institutions by accessing the following link:

The last date to fill and submit the Google Form is **7th September 2022.**

Candidates who do not fill the Preference Form, shall not be allotted seats for the programme.

In case the candidate wishes to apply for the same programme in multiple Institutions, s/he is required to submit a separate Form for each the Institution.

No Physical Counseling shall be conducted for the allotment of seats.

D. GU-ART: Candidates are requested to note the following details regarding the GU-ART.

- 1. Candidates shall be permitted to apply for a maximum of three subjects/specializations for the PG Programmes.**
2. Candidates who wish to apply for more than one programme for Round IV are required to use the same login details.
3. No changes shall be entertained after the application is submitted online.
4. The GU-ART shall be of One Paper of 100 marks, containing 50 objective Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) of 2 marks each. There shall be negative marking, where half a mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer. No marks shall be deducted for unanswered questions. The duration of the GU-ART shall be 90 minutes.
5. The breakup of 100 marks for the GU-ART Question Paper shall be as follows:
 - a. Section I (Least difficult) - 15 Questions
 - b. Section II (Difficult) - 15 Questions
 - c. Section III (Most difficult) - 20 Questions
6. In case candidates who have answered the GU-ART and have secured equal marks in the ranking list:
 - a. Section III scores shall be the first level of tie breaker, followed by Section II

- b. In case the tie still exists, the University shall decide the order of merit.

 8. A Common GU-ART shall be conducted for admission to
 - M.Sc. Environmental Science and MA Environmental Science.
 - Master of Commerce & Post Graduate Diploma in Finance and Taxation.
 9. Candidates answering the Round II GU-ART shall be ranked after the Round I candidates. Example: If 100 candidates apply for Round I, all 100 shall be assigned a rank based on the marks scored. For Round II, candidates shall be ranked from 101 onwards. The candidate scoring highest marks at GU-ART Round II shall be ranked 101.

GU-ART Schedule:

The GU-ART Round IV shall be held tentatively on 9th September 2022. The Confirmed dates shall be announced later.

The Test shall be held in ONLINE MODE.

Admission Process:

1. The results of **GU-ART Round IV** shall be displayed on the University Website tentatively by **10th September 2022**.
 - a. For **Programmes offered only at the University Schools/Departments or at a single College**, the seats shall be allotted to candidates based on their performance in the GU-ART. Rules/Guidelines for allotment of seats are given in [Annexure III](#). Candidates are **not required** to submit preferences for these programmes.
 - b. For **Programmes offered at both the University as well as the Affiliated Colleges or at multiple Colleges**, seats shall be allotted based on the preferences submitted by Candidates through the [Form \(Click here to refer List of Programmes\)](#). Allotment of seats shall be on the basis of availability of seats and preferences submitted by the candidates. Rules/Guidelines for allotment of seats are given in [Annexure III](#).
2. All Candidates including those who are Selected/Allotted/Offered seats at the Goa University Schools/Departments or Affiliated Colleges shall be required to pay the Seat Confirmation Fee of Rs.5,000/- online on the GUMS Portal.
3. Candidates answering the Round IV GU-ART Rounds shall be ranked after the Round III candidates.

4. The Admission for the academic year 2022-23 shall be based on the following Ordinances:

REFUND OF COURSE FEES

- a) If a student chooses to withdraw from the programme of study in which s/he is enrolled, the following five tier system shall be followed for the refund of fees remitted by her/him.

Sr. No.	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to the Institution	% of refund of Aggregate fees*
1.	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission. #	100%
2.	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission.	90%
3.	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission.	80%
4.	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after the formally notified last date of admission.	50%
5.	More than 30 days after the formally notified last date of admission.	0%

* Inclusive of tuition fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of Caution Deposit

Last date of admission shall be notified later on the university website.

- b) In case of (1) in the table above, 5% of the aggregate fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- shall be deducted as processing charges from the refundable amount.
- c) Fees shall be normally refunded to an eligible student within fifteen days from the date of receiving the application.
- d) All other cases of refund of fees will be decided on a case to case basis on its merit.

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ANNEXURE II
ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO PG PROGRAMMES

A) Shenoi Goembab School of Languages and Literature:

Master of Arts English, French, Hindi, Konkani, Marathi and Portuguese:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts, a candidate shall have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts General/ Honors of the University in the subject for which admission is sought or an examination of any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

B) D.D. Kosambi School of Social Sciences and Behavioural Studies:

i) Master of Arts in History, Political Science, Sociology, Geography and Psychology:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts a candidate shall have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) General/ Honors in the subject for which admission is sought of the University or any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

ii) Bachelor of Library and Information Science (B.L.I.Sc):

Graduates in any discipline of the University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto shall be eligible to apply for admission.

iii) Master of Library and Information Science (M.L.I.Sc):

Graduates in Library and Information Science with a minimum 40% of aggregate marks from any recognized university in India or abroad shall be eligible to apply.

C) Goa of Business School:

i) Master of Arts in Economics :

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Economics, a candidate must have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts General/ Honors of the University in the subject for which admission is sought or an examination of any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

ii) Masters of Commerce (M.Com):

To be eligible for admission to the programme leading to the Degree of Master of Commerce (M.Com.), a candidate must have passed the examination for the Degree of B.Com/BBA/BBA(FS), of this University or an examination of any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

iii) Master of Travel and Tourism Management:

To be eligible for admission to the programme leading to the Degree of Master of Travel and Tourism Management, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

D) School of Physical and Applied Sciences:

i) Master of Science in Mathematics and Physics:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Mathematics and Physics, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in the subject for which admission is sought of the University or any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

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ii) Master of Science in Electronics:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Electronics, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science with Physics/ Computer Science/ Electronics of the University or from any other recognised University.

E] School of Biological Sciences and Biotechnology:

i) Master of Science in Microbiology, Botany and Zoology:

To be eligible for admission to Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Microbiology/Botany/Zoology, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in the subject for which admission is sought of the University or any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

ii) Master of Science in Biotechnology & Marine Biotechnology:

Candidates having Bachelor's Degree in Natural / Biological & Clinical Sciences, Agricultural / Veterinary / Fishery Sciences / Pharmacy / Engineering / Technology or 4-years B.Sc. (Physician Assistant) or Medicine (MBBS) or B.D.S., with at least 55% marks, shall be eligible for the Programmes. Admissions to Marine Biotechnology Admissions are granted on the basis of the National Combined Entrance Examination in Biotechnology conducted by Jawaharlal Nehru University(New Delhi) at various centres.

iii) Master of Science in Food Technology:

A Candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in Food Science / Food Technology / Microbiology / Biotechnology / Biochemistry / Life Sciences/ Biological Sciences / Home Science / Food, Nutrition and Dietetics and Allied Sciences OR four years Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture/ Veterinary/ Forestry/ Pharmacy/ Fishery Sciences / B.E. (Biochemical / Biotechnology)/ B.Tech (Biochemical / Biotechnology/ Food Science / Food Technology).

iv) Post Graduate Diploma in Medical Laboratory Techniques (PGDMLT)

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Diploma in Medical Laboratory Techniques must have passed the examination of degree of Bachelor of Science of this University or from any other recognized University, with at least 32 credits in the first, second and third years taken together under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in the subject of either Microbiology, Bio-technology, or Zoology, and must have offered Chemistry as a subject upto the second year level. In Semester system of examination, the number of papers or units shall be 14, with a total of 1400 marks, out of which eight papers are studied in F.Y. and S.Y. taken together and minimum 6 papers in T.Y. for being eligible for PG admission in that subject.

F] School of Chemical Sciences:

i) Master of Science in Chemistry:

- a) To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Chemistry, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science of the University General/ Honors or from any other recognized University, in the subject for which admission is sought.
- b) Candidates applying for admission to the M.Sc. Programme in Chemistry shall be eligible to be admitted to only one of the various specialisations at M. Sc., Part II, as notified in the University Prospectus.
- c) Allotment of seats under various specializations of the Master's Programme in Chemistry, shall be specified in the University Prospectus.

ii) Master of Science in Biochemistry:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Biochemistry, a candidate shall have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors of this University or from any other recognized University. in Chemistry / Biological Sciences (Botany, Zoology/ Microbiology/ Biochemistry/ Biotechnology and allied subjects.

G] School of Earth, Ocean and Atmospheric Sciences:

(i) Master of Science in Applied Geology:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Applied Geology, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors of the University or from any other recognized University, in the subject for which admission is sought.

(ii) Master of Science in Marine Science:

a) To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Marine Science Programme, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science of the University or from any other recognized University, in Mathematics/ Physics/ Chemistry/ Biology/ Hydrochemistry/ Environmental Science / Environmental Chemistry/ Marine Science/Ocean Science/Biotechnology. A candidate with BSc Geography /B.C.A with mathematics at HSSC level is also eligible.

(iii) Master of Science in Marine Microbiology:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Marine Microbiology, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in Microbiology/ Biotechnology of the University or from any other recognized University.

(iv) Master of Science in Environmental Science/ Master of Arts in Environmental Studies:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Environmental Science, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors of the University or from any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Environmental Science must have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts General/ Honors of the University or an examination of any other University recognised.

H] School of International and Area Studies:

(i) MA International Studies:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in International Studies, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

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I] Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance & Public Policy:

(i) Master of Social Work:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Social Studies a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

(ii) Master of Arts in Women's Studies:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Women's Studies, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

(iii) Master of Arts in Public Administration:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Public Administration, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

J] School of Sanskrit, Philosophy and Indic Studies:

(i) Master of Arts in Philosophy:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Philosophy, a candidate must have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts General/ Honors in the subject of Philosophy from this University or any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

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ANNEXURE III

RULES FOR SELECTION

RANK LISTS FOR ALL PROGRAMMES SHALL BE NOTIFIED ON THE WEBSITE ON 10th September 2022.

Selection of Candidates for programmes which are offered at a single location

Lists of Selected Candidates shall be declared on the website on 10th September 2022. Selected Candidates shall be offered admission on a provisional basis and shall have to pay the Seat Confirmation Fee of INR.5,000/- on GUMS.

Selection of Candidates for programmes which are offered at multiple locations/Institutions.

For Programmes which are offered at both the University as well as the Affiliated Colleges or at multiple Colleges, seats shall be allotted based on the rank obtained in GU-ART, availability of seats and preferences submitted by Candidates through the Form.

NO PHYSICAL COUNSELING WILL BE CONDUCTED FOR THE ALLOTMENT OF SEATS.

List of selected candidates shall be declared on the website by 10th September 2022. Selected Candidates shall be offered admission on a provisional basis and shall have to pay the Seat Confirmation Fee of INR.5,000/- on GUMS.

General

1. If a candidate after securing admission to a programme wishes to transfer her/his seat from a University School/Department to another or from a College programme to University School/Department and vice versa her/his fee shall be transferred or refunded as per UGC Rules.
2. All Seats which were allotted at Round I, Round II & Round III but were not confirmed by the candidates by payment of Seat Confirmation Fees will be offered to other eligible candidates.
3. Vacant Reserved category seats after 1st Provisional List of Round I are transferred to Un-Reserved Category only.
4. Post declaration of the qualifying examination results, eligible candidates shall be given time to verify the documents and enroll for the programme by paying the balance fees.
5. **The Seat Confirmation Fee is fully refundable only in case of candidate's failure to pass the qualifying examination.**

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
