### **Report of the One Day Workshop on Writing Manuscripts and Publishing Quality Research Journals**

**27th August 2022**

The Directorate of Internal Quality Assurance (DIQA), Goa University has organized one day workshop on “Writing Manuscripts and Publishing Quality Research Journals” on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2022. The workshop was attended by nearly 250 participants which included the faculty members of Goa University and affiliated colleges who are at the entry level of their carrier, research scholars of Goa University and IQAC coordinators, librarians of the affiliated colleges of Goa University.

The workshop began with an inaugural function at 9:30 am.

The session began with a welcome address by Prof. S. Dhuri, Director, DIQAC.

The Chief Guest of the inaugural function Prof. H.B. Menon, Vice Chancellor, Goa University spoke on the significance of publishing in quality research journals and some of the important points to keep in mind while writing a research paper. He wished all the participants to publish at least one article in the reputed journal after taking inputs from the workshop.

Dr. Gopakumar V., Librarian, Digital University Kerala, was the resource person for the first session of the workshop. In his session on ‘Literature Search and Reference Management’ he discussed on how literature review and references can be managed easily with the use of some softwares. He demonstrated how Mendeley can be used very effectively for literature search. He showed how Mendeley and Endnote software’s can be used to generate bibliography and references. He also spoke on research matrices.

The second session by Prof. Gopakumar covered “Ethical Issues in Publishing”. He discussed what amounts to Plagiarism? What care has to be taken while quoting from other sources to avoid plagiarism. What are the different methods and styles of quotation. Both the sessions were delivered in an interactive way.

Dr. M.Tapaswi, in the in the post lunch session highlighted on selecting a Journal for publishing. In his session he discussed what are Care List I, Care List II and Scopus journals. What are predatory and cloned journals and how one must take extreme precaution while selecting a good journal for publishing without falling prey to the predatory journals. He demonstrated to the participants by showing examples, how to identify which is the predatory or cloned journal. The session ended with question and answer session.

In the Valedictory Function Prof. Revankar spoke on the significance of quality research work and asked the participants to ensure on the quality in their research and publications and not to resort to easy way out.

The workshop ended with a vote of thanks by Dr. Alaknanda Shringare
