## Report

Organised: A Day Long State Level Workshop on “Towards Access to Justice and  
Inclusive Development of Marginalized Groups in Goa”.**



The UGC Centre for study of social exclusion and inclusive policy, D. D. Kosambi School of Social Science and Behavioural Studies at Goa University Organized One days a State Level Workshop on Towards Access to Justice and Inclusive Development of Marginalized Groups in Goa' on 1<sup>st</sup> Feb.2023 from 9.30 am – 1.30 pm, at the Faculty Block B, Goa University.

In the inaugural session, Prof. Ganesh Somayaji, the Dean, D. D. Kosambi School of Social Science and Behavioural Studies and the coordinator of the CSSEIP, Goa University, welcome and request to lighting the traditional lamp to Chief Guest, Hon'ble Minister Shri Subhash Shirodkar, for Water Resource Development, Co-Operation Provedoria, and Government of Goa and Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Goa University, Senior Professor Harila Menon was Guest of Honour.

Dr. Joanna Pereira Coelho, Vice Dean Research, D. D. Kosambi School of Social Science and Behavioural Studies, Goa University, introduced the concept and objective of the workshop and also highlighted the objectives of the centre and its relevance in Goa.

Senior Professor Harila Menon, Vice-Chancellor of Goa University, in his inaugural address, has touched upon various aspects of Access to Justice and Inclusive Development of

Marginalized Groups. He said that university has to be a part of the society and it should work as a catalyst and a link between different parts of society.



Chief Guest, Hon'ble Minister Shri Subhash Shirodkar, in his inaugural address, opined that the Right to Education has been passed by the Parliament, but it is still far from being a reality. In Goa, very few marginalized communities have ownership over land or productive assets. This proves to be a roadblock in decision making and inclusive development. He proposed to create an environment that encourages research on problem of marginalized communities. Also, he stressed the importance promotes affirmative action policies such as agriculture and rural development and encourages dialogue and building links between marginalized communities leaders and networks and rural development organisations.

First inaugural session was concluded with a formal Vote of Thanks by Dr. Vijay M. Gawas, Assistant professor, UGC Centre for study of social exclusion and inclusive policy, D. D. Kosambi School of Social Science and Behavioural Studies at Goa University.

The second technical session was chaired by Dr. Joanna Pereira Coelho, Vice Dean Research, D. D. Kosambi School of Social Science and Behavioural Studies, Goa University. Priya Mishra welcomed and introduced the Guest speakers for the talk. Four papers were presented in the session. Mr. Arvind Khutkar, Managing Director, Goa State Scheduled Tribes Finance and Development Corporation Limited, Government of Goa in his presentation on 'Plans, Policies, and Programmes undertaken for the welfare of Tribal Communities in Goa' has



depicted various schemes for tribal communities implemented by the government departments for welfare of tribal people in the state of Goa.



Dr.Sonal Sardessai Assistant Professor, V.M. Salgaocar College of law, Miramar - Panjim, Goa in her presentation on Constitutional and Legal Rights of Empowering Women. The Resource Persons Dr.Sonal Sardessai spoke on the rights available to woman in India can be classified into two categories, namely as constitutional rights and legal rights. The constitutional rights are those which are provided in the various provisions of the constitution. The legal rights, on the other hand, are those which are provided in the various laws (acts) of the Parliament and the State Legislatures. She focused on Legal Rights to Women: The following various legislation's contained several rights and safeguards for women: Maternity Benefit Act (1961) regulates the employment of women in certain establishments for certain period before and after child-birth and provides for maternity benefit and certain other benefits. She explained the importance of Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act (1971) provides for the termination of certain pregnancies by registered medical practitioners on humanitarian and medical grounds. Also, She stressed the importance of Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act (1994) prohibits sex selection before or after conception and prevents the misuse of pre-natal diagnostic techniques for sex determination leading to female feticides and further contributes to expand the scope of social justice for woman in India.

Mr. Taha Haaziq Secretary, Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities, Government of Goa in his presentation on Constitutional and Legal Rights of Persons with Disabilities. He insisted that Firstly, efforts should be taken to help them to overcome the multiple deprivations which have been keeping them marginalised. Secondly, to provide them protection against social exclusion and socio-economic discrimination on the one side and on the other, encourage these groups' effective participation in the mainstream of the governance.

Mr. Upasso Gaonkar President of All India Adiwasi Employees Federation Goa State in his presentation on Voices of Tribal people of Goa. He shared that the one of the most marginalized communities in Goa are the tribal communities, who despite special enabling provisions for them in the Constitution, a legal framework for the implementation of these provisions and several targeted public policy initiatives, and they have continued to suffer deprivations of different kinds. Also, he stressed, that the rights guaranteed to the tribal Population have been grossly violated. The tribal population not only face severe socio-economic marginalization but also the threat of undermining of their distinctive culture and identity, which in turn is rooted in their livelihood patterns. He insisted, as a civil society to have a dialogue with Government regarding effective and inclusive implementation of policy so that development takes place for tribal community.



The workshop concluded by formulating the following Action Points that to find out the gaps in the implementation of policies and show a report to concerned departments and Prepare a database of their work intervention of all NGOs/CSOs for sharing with the OBC/ST/SC/PH



Welfare department for their support. The workshop concluded with a formal Vote of Thanks by Cleodel Quentin Pereira, student of Semester-II Sociology, Goa University. The Workshop was open to all the student and the faculty of Goa University. Around more than 200 participant included the media attended the workshop.
