SCS Inter-section Football League – Goa University ground (July 8th 2022 – 3rd August 2022)

Extracurricular activities besides providing opportunity for students to demonstrate their talents, also helps in building students and teachers interpersonal relationships. The SCS inter-section football league is one of the events which makes this possible. It was inaugurated on July 8th, 2022, by Prof. V. M. S. Verenkar Dean, SCS, at the main ground of the Goa University. The league witnessed enthusiastic participation from four teams; namely Analytical Spectra, Inorganic Ferrites, Organic Isomers and Physical Electrolytes with each team consisting of 7 players. League showed immense participation of various students, teachers and other non-teaching staff. Those who could not get into their respective teams were found cheering off the field.

The matches were scheduled on Fridays (schedule enclosed). The league followed a round-robin format, with each team playing against every other team in the league. Each match consisted of two halves of 15 minutes each, and the team scoring the most number of goals was declared the winner. The league witnessed some intense matches, with each team giving their best on the field. The matches were closely contested, and the players displayed excellent skills, agility and teamwork.

After three weeks of rigorous competition, the league concluded with the final match played on 03rd August 2022 between the two best teams i.e., Organic Isomers vs Physical Electrolytes. The final match was a thrilling encounter, with both teams giving their best on the field. In the end, the team Organic Isomers emerged as the winners, beating the team Physical electrolytes with a score of 2-1 in enthralling penalty shootout. The winning team displayed excellent teamwork, coordination, and skills throughout the tournament. Dr. Rupesh Anta Kunkalkar was the highest scorer in the league with 3 goals on his name.

Overall, the SCS inter-section football league was a great success, with enthusiastic participation from the students, faculties, non-teaching staff of School of Chemical Sciences. The tournament provided an excellent platform for the students, faculties, non-teaching staff to showcase their skills and compete against their peers from sections of the school. The trophy for this tournament was Donated by Dean, SCS prof. VSM Verenkar and football ground, footballs and other requirements taken from sports section Goa University.

The league not only promoted sportsmanship and teamwork but also encouraged healthy competition and a sense of camaraderie among the students. The success of the league has set the stage for more such sporting events in the future, which will undoubtedly help in fostering a spirit of sportsmanship and teamwork among the students, faculties as well as in non-teaching staff.
