SCS cricket league - SCS premises (14th Feb 2023 – 8th March 2023)

The School of Chemical Sciences (SCS) cricket league commenced on 14th Feb 2023, and it comprised of four teams and was played over two weeks. The cricket league was organized to provide students with a platform to showcase their cricketing skills, as well as to promote teamwork, sportsmanship, and healthy competition among the students. This report provides a detailed analysis of the SCS cricket league.

The SCS cricket league consisted of four teams, namely Jaguars, Daredevils, Stormbreakers and Tyrants. Each team had 8 players and all teams were evenly matched, which resulted in some exciting and closely contested matches. The matches were held on the school's cricket ground, which was cleaned and marked by our own students. The league was played in a round-robin format, with each team playing against the other three teams. The top two teams with the highest number of points at the end of the round-robin stage qualified for the finals.

All matches were played with great enthusiasm and sportsmanship. The players displayed a high level of skill and competitive spirit, and the matches were closely contested. The league matches were played over two weeks (Schedule enclosed), with two matches held each day. The league matches were followed by the finals, which were played between the two teams that qualified from the round-robin stage. Jaguars and Stormbreakers proceeded into the final match on the basis of run rate difference of 0.03.

The inauguration of the final was done on March 8th 2023 by Prof. Sunder N. Dhuri, Vice-Dean (Academic), SCS. The finals were played in front of a large and enthusiastic crowd of students, faculties and non-teaching staff which added to the excitement of the occasion. The SCS cricket league was a huge success, and it achieved its objectives of promoting teamwork, sportsmanship, and healthy competition among the students.
