Detail of the Resource Person (Brief biodata)	Shekhar Sardessai: Shekhar Sardessai, is the founder and Managing Director of Kineco Group comprising of parent company Kineco Limited and its two multinational joint ventures, Kineco Kaman Composites India Private Limited and KinecoExel Composites India Private Limited. A Fabrication Engineer by qualification from Government Polytechnic Panaji, Shekhar founded Kineco as a small-scale unit in 1995, after serving for 8 years in some of the world-class engineering and manufacturing companies in India across various disciplines of manufacturing, project management, product development and marketing. Kineco's railway division is the leader in providing modular turnkey solutions for interiors across the entire range of Indian trains such as LHB, Tejas and Train 18. Kineco's Defence and Space division has pioneered the development of many first of its kind composite products such as sonar domes for naval warships, carbon

fibre modular bridges for military applications, besides contributing significantly to a range of indigenous missile programs such as Agni 4 and 5 and space launch vehicle programs such GSLV, PSLV and Gaganyan. Kineco's decade-old joint venture with Kaman Aerospace Group USA (NYSE listed company) has made its mark as a world-class provider of composite products and sub systems to the global aerospace markets serving its customers on Airbus and Boeing platforms besides being the largest manufacturer of composite parts for indigenous aircrafts and helicopters such as LCA and ALH manufactured by HAL. The stupendous success of Kineco Kaman, has recently landed Kineco in yet another joint venture with Exel Composite of Finland – the world's largest producer of pultruded composite products.
