*Report on talk by Prof. Paritosh Mohanty on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2023*

The School of Chemical Sciences organized a seminar on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2023 at 11.00 am on the topic “Ancient Indian Science and its Relevance to Modern Indian Science”. The talk was delivered by Prof. Paritosh Mohanty from IIT, Roorkee.

Prof. Mohanty is a materials chemist who has done his PhD from IIT Kharagpur. Before joining IIT Roorkee, he was senior research scientist at Department of Chemistry, Lehigh University. His research area focuses on nanoporous inorganic-organic hybrid materials for environmental applications. Prof. Mohanty’s talk was mainly aimed at educating the public the significance of ancient Indian science and many of the discoveries that were first made by Indian rishis and gurus and how we should try to inculcate the values of rich Indian culture in young generation. He emphasized that important discoveries revealed by western countries has an Indian root. He further added that the solutions to the scientific problems of today’s world lies in ancient Indian science. Thus, the aim of creating awareness among the teachers and students about rich ancient Indian scientific culture was achieved by this talk.


The seminar was coordinated by Mr. Vishnu Chari. Dr. Pranay introduced the speaker.

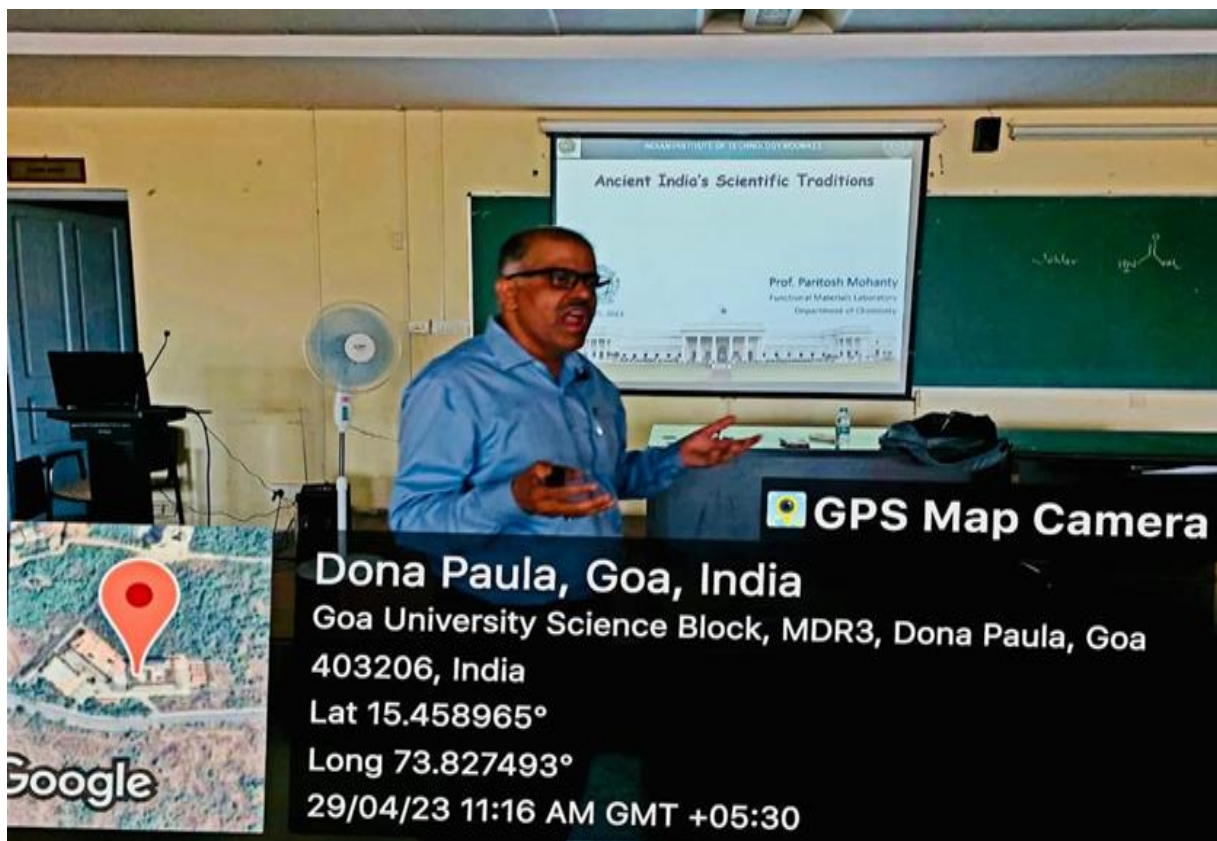
