- Celebration of Konkani writer and his oeuvre: The Department of Indian Languages (Konkani) organized a programme on 23rd June 2023 to commemorate the 146th birth anniversary of the Father of Konkani Literature Shenvoi Goembab. Principal Prof. Vrinda Borker garlanded the portrait of Shenvoi Goembab in the presence of administrator Shri Rajesh Bhatikar. Students and teachers offered floral tribute to the portrait. Mrs. Anju Sakhardande made a powerpoint presentation highlighting the contribution of this great Goan while Mrs. Vidita Shet compered at the same. 70 students benefited from this programme.

4. Promoting sensitization in youth: The Department of Psychology organized a certificate course titled “Mental Health among Deaf & Blind Individuals: Training & Interventions” of 30 hours from 29th September, 2022 to 14th April, 2023. 5.
