Kindly find enclosed herewith details for Inter College Chess (Mix) and Swimming (M & W).

1. Chess Mix

- i) The Inter-Collegiate Chess (Mix) Championship will be held at S. Caculo College, Mapusa from 1st to 3rd August 2023 from 9.30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
- ii) Rules of the Chess Federation of India shall apply to the Inter-College Chess Tournament unless, otherwise, modified in these rules.
- iii) The tournament will be played according to the Swiss Method (nine rounds).
- iv) A team may consist of minimum 4 players and maximum 6 players (including two reserve players). Only four players shall be allowed to participate each playing against the other of the same status in order of ranking:
- v) Each college shall enter the names in eligibility as per **Board Order** for the first round and **FIDE ID in remark column** if available. The reserve shall be ranked at the bottom.
- vi) In the event of inability of a playing member to participate, the ranking order shall be changed in such a way that only the player following him in the ladder takes his place and so on. No player shall be replaced during the course of the tournament.
- vii) The last date to confirm the team and submit eligibility in excel sheet format to University Sports section through email at <u>sports@unigia.ac.in</u> is 22/07/2023 till 5.00 p.m.

Note: Each participating team has to bring Two Chess Boards and Two Chess Clocks of their own.

2. SWIMMING FOR MEN & WOMEN

- The Inter-Collegiate Swimming Championship for Men & Women will be held at Swimming Pool, Campal Indoor Stadium/ Ponda sports complex on 4th August 2023 from 9.30 a.m. onwards.
- ii) Events for Men Section are 100 m free style, 200 m free style, 100 m breast stroke, 100 m back stroke and 100 m butterfly.

- iii) Events for Women Section are 50 m free style, 100 m free style, 50 m breast stroke, 50 m back stroke and 50 m butterfly.
- iv) A college can enter only two participants in each event and one participant can participate in two events only.
- v) Colleges should submit the best timing of their swimmer.
- vi) Swimmers shall be seeded for the heats in accordance with the times submitted on the official entry form. Those, who do not give timings, will be considered the slowest.
- vii) Eight best swimmers shall be advanced to the finals on the basis of their timings in the heats.
- viii) The number of heats shall be determined according to the number of competitors and the lanes available. in the pool (preferably 8 lanes).
- ix) There shall be a minimum of three swimmers. entered/ seeded for the conduct of any event/heat/final
- x) The last date to submit eligibility in Excel Sheet format along with the Event wise entry & Best timing form to University Sports section through email at <u>Sports@unigoa.ac.in</u> is 26th July 2023.
- xi) College Directors of Physical Education and Sports must ensure that all the participants are medically fit. Goa University will not ask for medical certificates and also will not be responsible for any medical complications.
- xii) All the teams must carry their own first aid kits.

Note Please:

- **1.** The Eligibility Performa should have the University Registration Number of all the students, who have been issued the same.
- 2. Re admission/repetition of a class/course by a student should be indicated in remarks Column of the eligibility performa.
