RBI has to take policy measures to revive the economy by printing more money or by reduction in the fixed deposit rates. Investors will become unhappy due to this. Investors will have to look out for alternatives by starting investment in bonds and mutual funds. As the yield starts to become attractive the investors start investments in equity, Stock prices also go up. The price rise leads to portfolio appreciation which leads to a positive wealth maximization effect. Wealth maximization is a feel-good factor which leads to increase in spending and therefore growth and development in the economy. The webinar was attended by 80 students of FY B Com and SY B Com.

Nirmala Institute of Education Altinho, Panaji

1. The Lecture on Developing a Health Promoting University: Models & Framework for Action was organised by UGC's Chetana Online Lecture Series on Best Practices in Higher Education on the 16th August, 2022 at 10:00 am. The students were seated in the college hall before the lecture began. Dr Russell de Souza introduced the topic and explain the flow of the program. The program began with a brief introduction on Dr. Rajiv Yeravde, the Dean, faculty of Health and Science Symbiosis International (Deemed University). Dr Yeravde started the lecture by highlighting the ways the higher education system of India works and what does university education provide. He emphasised on the different health conditions such as mental health, physical inactivity, sleep disorders and the various problems of availability accessibility and affordability. Dr Yeravde explained the different factors influencing the learning outcomes and how universities should develop into model health promoting units. The motto of the Ottawa charter for health promotion 1986 was stated and the 8 Standards of practice for health promotion was dealt with in brief. Dr Yeravde spoke about the importance of enabling health, wellbeing and sustainable development and focused on the 3 main areas Integrating health and sustainability into core business. The settings-based approach (SBA) given by the WHO, its objectives such as improving primary care, social

environment, healthy physical environment, developing links with the community, supportive campus environment, youth centric activities were brought to our attention. Reasons for investing in health promoting universities, policy formulation, the various challenges and problems were briefly explained and ended at 10:45. The lecture was followed by a question-and-answer session and a brief discussion on the above topic. The Lecture was informative and well explained. It led the students to think about how health, be it, physical or mental can have an impact on our learning process and how we can help create health promoting universities.
