Dr. Harip Khanapuri, Associate Professor and Director of Foreign students welcomed the students and briefed them on the Ragging situation in the country with the social implication on the minds of victims. Dr. Priva D'Costa, Assistant Professor and Chief Warden of Women's Hostel introduced the resource person Dr. Ganesha Somayaji, Dean and Professor of Sociology. The resource person began by highlighting the objectives mentioned by UGC on Anti-ragging and then elaborated on what constitutes ragging, the punishable offences and punishments to be faced by accused according to law along with measures taken to curb the menace of ragging among the students in the campus. Mr. Abhinay Pai, Warden of Men's Hostel proposed the vote of thanks. 
