

Description of the Program/activity/event	The 3-Day conference begun with an inaugural function that included lighting of the lamp by the dignitaries on the dais followed by welcome address by Prof. Savita Kerkar, Dean School of Biological Sciences and Biotechnology, Goa University and the Chairperson of the local organizing committee and the Chief guest for the day. The conference comprised of 2 keynote addresses, 4 plenary talk sessions with 16 speakers in total, 6 scientific sessions held parallelly with 32 speakers and 3 turbo talk sessions with a total of 45 participants. 3 poster presentation sessions were also held that received a large number of participants. Apart from this, the General body meeting of NAVBD took place on day 2 along with the Panel discussion on novel tool and technologies for VBD Diagnosis and control that took place on day 3. A Special session was also held where in various industries were provided an opportunity to present the work and career opportunities their organization provided. The conference concluded with a valedictory function during which all prize winners were awarded.
