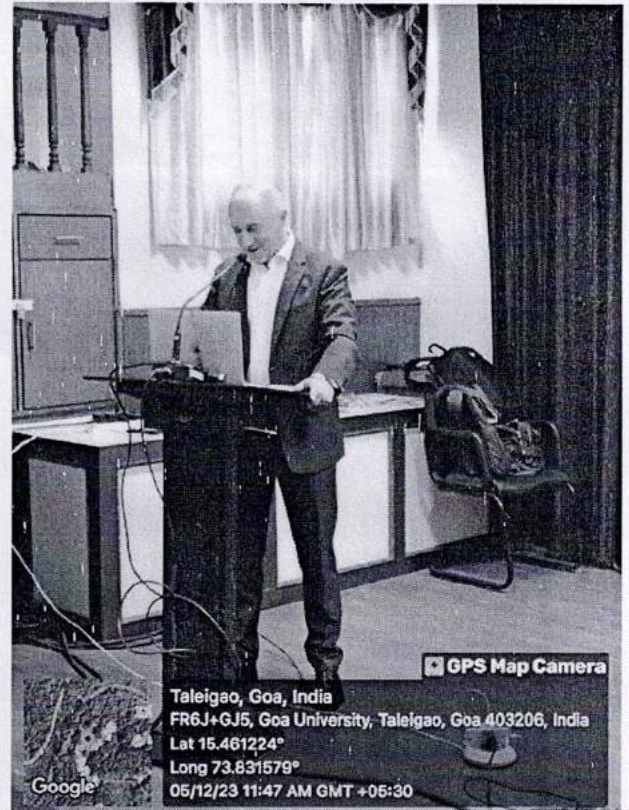

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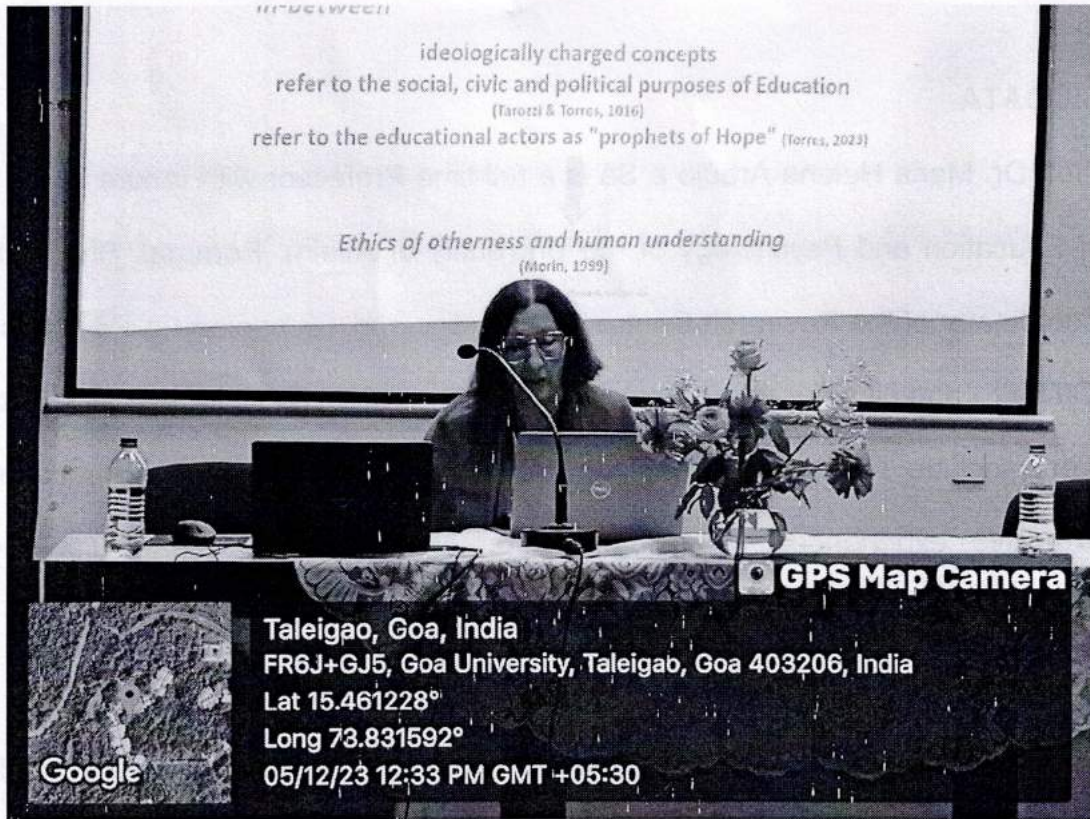

She has extensive experience in training in international contexts, particularly in language education.

Prof. Dr. Filomena Martins is an Assistant Professor at the Department of Education and Psychology of the University of Aveiro (Portugal) and a member of the Research Centre on Didactics and Technology in the Education of Trainers. She participates in international projects concerning teacher education and language education, linguistic diversity, inter-comprehension, pluri-lingualism and multiculturalism. She is an associate partner of the project "Resources for assessing the home language competences of migrant pupils" of the ECML, Council of Europe and member of the Association EDILIC (www.edilic.org).
