Sub.: Report of activities on Vigilance Awareness Week 2023




B. Online Quiz Competition on Vigilance Awareness for Goa University Staff and their family members

Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance and Public Policy held an online quiz competition on November 13th, 2023 at 3:00 pm for the staff and their families. Thirteen staff members and twelve family members of the staff took part in the quiz. The subject of the quiz was general knowledge about e-governance and the Central Vigilance Commission to create transparency. Ms. Divya Parmar, Assistant Prof. Public Administration, Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance and Public Policy was the coordinator of the quiz. Twenty questions were asked during the quiz. Out of Twenty-five participants, sixteen participants scored eighteen and above which indicates good awareness among the staff and their family members. D. Workshop on "Say No to Corruption, Commit to the Nation"- Preventive Vigilance a tool to Good Governance held for staff members of Directorates Office

At the Directorates Office, a workshop on "Say No to Corruption, Commit to the Nation"- Preventive Vigilance a tool to Good Governance, was held for the staff members on 10th November, 2023 from 4:00 p.m to 5:30 p.m. The co-ordinators of the workshop were Shashikant Muraikar (Assistant Registrar) and Surekha Naik (Sr. Editorial Assistant). Fifty-one staff members attended the workshop. Dr. Snehal Naik Goltekar was the resource person. The staff members were introduced about the history behind the vigilance awareness week and also about how all government servants are bound to know and understand content of Article 209 and Article 311 of Indian Constitution such as CCS Conduct Rules (Do's and Don'ts of Govt. Servants). The resource person explained about how preventive vigilance is key to good governance and its aim towards reducing lapse during work along with laws to combat corruption. A video clip was shown for better understanding about the adverse effects of corruption on family as well as on self. The resource person also emphasized on the fact that an employee should have self-realization about his or her duty as government employees.











Botany Microbiology Biotechnology School of biological Sciences and Biotechnology (SBSB)
