She has delivered over 40 lectures at various national and international platforms and has a number of publications in her name. Among various publications, recently published works are "Journalistic Responsibility in the Age of Commercialism" in Justice and Responsibility: Relearning to be Human (published by The Council for Research in Philosophy: Washington, D.C., 2020); "A Gandhian Solution to the Problem of Religious Intolerance" in Re-thinking Religious Pluralism (published by Springer Nature: Singapore, 2021); "Understanding Aurobindo's Concept of Nationalism: An Integral Philosophy or a Religious Faith?" in Reading Sri Aurobindo (published by Springer Nature: Singapore, 2022). She has supervised 6 Ph.D. theses, 1 Post-Doctoral work and 6 M. Phil dissertations. She has been conferred with the 'Gandhi Award' from Gandhi Bhawan, University of Delhi. She has been a visiting faculty at IIM, Rohtak in 2021 and 2023. She is the mentor of MAP (Minorities and Philosophy, University of Delhi chapter), an international network of students that aims to address issues of inclusivity and minority participation in Philosophy.
