

He is an acclaimed Brazilian scholar, with extensive publications on “the communicational condition of human being”, which functions both as a critical discourse on Western modernity and a bridge for a emancipatory dialogue with Eastern thought. 

Description of the Program/activity/event          | <p><b>The Philosophical Therapy of Mind and Truth</b></p> <p><i>Abstract</i><br/> As academic critical judgment, social movements, science and liberalism seem powerless to effectively oppose barbarism, the concept <i>Mental Territory</i> (2009) is seminal in my contribution for the ontological turn for hegemonic social theory and philosophy towards non-duality, as I am experimenting and researching in India and Japan : it is the <i>mind</i>, the "<i>mental images</i>", that defines the reality we live in, the "<i>material images</i>". Philosophical reason, when understood as an <i>clarifying reason</i> (<i>Upanishads</i>) and <i>non-instaaurative reason</i>, as in West, constitutes itself as a therapeutic discipline, in which being and thinking, truth and happiness are reconciled through the experience of a transvalued truth, non-metaphysical and non-postmodern, therefore of a <i>communicational nature</i>. This <i>Third Structure of Truth</i> provides the reference for <i>transcultural ethics</i>, promoting emancipatory and soteriological solidarity that overcome the <i>fakemind</i> (2019), without implying, as demonstrated by the Kyoto School, a formal identity, the dissolution of difference or rejection of logic.</p> |
