‘A Legal Odyssey’ at Goa University

The Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance, and Public Policy, Goa University, in collaboration with its MoU partner Faculdade de Direito, Universidade de Lisboa (FDUL) and Lisbon Public Law Research Centre, organized a guest lecture on ‘A Legal Odyssey’ in international law.

The guest speakers, Professor Doutor Fernando Loureiro Bastos, senior faculty at FDUL, spoke on ‘Law of the Sea: Recent Developments,’ highlighting the changing nature of international law and territory with sea-level rise due to climate change. Professor Doutora Ana Rita Gil spoke on ‘Migration by Sea,’ focusing on the ‘boat people’—illegal migrants seeking refuge and their human rights, with a special focus on the European Courts.
