11. Description of the Program/activity/event	 Mr. D.N. Bagali presented an overview of SEBI, its regulatory powers, and elaborated on key investor regulations and its overall functioning. Ms. Rupal Khandelwal briefed about the key concepts of investment which an investor must be aware of before venturing into investment in the stock market. She clarified various myths and misconceptions about investments and also warned about the prevailing fraudulent practices in the area of investment. Mr. Sanjay Nunes discussed the key role and functioning of CDSL in delivering depository services in the stock market. He elaborated on concepts such as dematerialization, rematerialization, and pledging of securities and detailed the rights and obligations on the part of the depository service providers.


