

Description of the Program/activity/event	<p>The Inaugural function of the CBP was held on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2024 at 10.00 am in the VRPP Hall, Block D, Directorates Building, Goa University. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Goa University, Sr. Prof. Dr. Harilal B. Menon was present as the chief guest. Shri Sagun Velip, Director of Art &amp; Culture Goa was the guest of honour. Dr. Sandesh B. Dessai, University Librarian &amp; Coordinator of the program, Dr. B.V. Sharma, Director of RRRLF &amp; Shri Dipanjan Chatterjee, Program officer of NML were also present on the dias.</p> <p>Following the inaugural function 3 sessions were conducted for the participants.</p> <p>On 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> February 4 sessions each were conducted. On 18<sup>th</sup> February 2 sessions were conducted in Krishnadas Shama State Central Library, Goa following the library visits after lunch.</p> <p>On 19<sup>th</sup> February 3 sessions were conducted which was followed by the valedictory function at 3.00 p.m. Sr. Prof. Dr. Vishnu S. Nadkarni, Registrar of Goa University was present as a chief guest for the function. Dr. Sushant Tandel, Curator, Krishnadas Shama Goa State Central Library, Goa, was present as a guest of honor. Participants provided feedback of the organization of the program.</p>

	The program ended at 5.30 with the distribution of the certificates to the participants.
<b>12. Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event</b>	<p>Capacity Building Program was a journey of knowledge, growth, and collaboration. The diverse sessions conducted during this program, ranging from "Emerging Trends in Public Libraries: Current and Future" to "IPR &amp; Copyright in the Digital Environment," and sessions on "Modern ICT Tools and Techniques with Special Reference to AI Tools for Public Libraries," equipped the participants with a comprehensive set of skills and knowledge.</p> <p>The program also delved into specific areas crucial for public library personnel, such as sessions on Koha, soft skills development, book binding, preservation techniques, and library services catering to Divyangjan. These sessions were not just theoretical knowledge but practical tools that the public library staff can use to enhance their skills and better serve the communities they engage with. In addition to public library personnel, the benefit was also gained by some students and staff of Goa University Library as well as College Librarians from Goa.</p>



# CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME of National Mission on Libraries for PUBLIC LIBRARY PERSONNEL



## National Mission on Libraries (NML)

National Mission on Libraries i.e. High Level Committee, was set up by Ministry of Culture, Government of India, vide Notification No. 18-4/2009\_Lib (Pt) dated 4th May, 2012 in pursuance of National Knowledge Commission recommendations for sustained attention for development of Libraries and Information Science Sector.

National Mission on Libraries set up four working groups and after deliberating on the recommendations of the working groups formulated the scheme "National Mission on Libraries (NML) - upgradation of libraries providing service to the public". The scheme consists of four components.

### Creation of National Virtual Library of India (NVLI)

*NVLI has been envisaged to create a comprehensive repository of digital resources on information about India and information generated in India. NVLI would facilitate dissemination of such information to the citizens in an open access environment through multilingual federated search interfaces.*

### Setting up of NML Model Libraries

*Under the scheme of Setting up on NML Model Libraries, 6 Libraries under the Ministry of Culture, 35 State Central Libraries and 35 District Libraries are to be developed as model Libraries.*

### Quantitative & Qualitative Survey of Libraries

*The Quantitative Survey of Libraries has been undertaken to prepare a baseline data on existing infrastructure & resources available in public libraries in India through a survey of 5000 Libraries. The qualitative survey has been undertaken to collect data from 7000 users & non-users to understand the need and expectation of citizens from the Public Library.*

### Capacity Building

*The Capacity Building programme is being organized to enhance the professional competence of library personnel.*



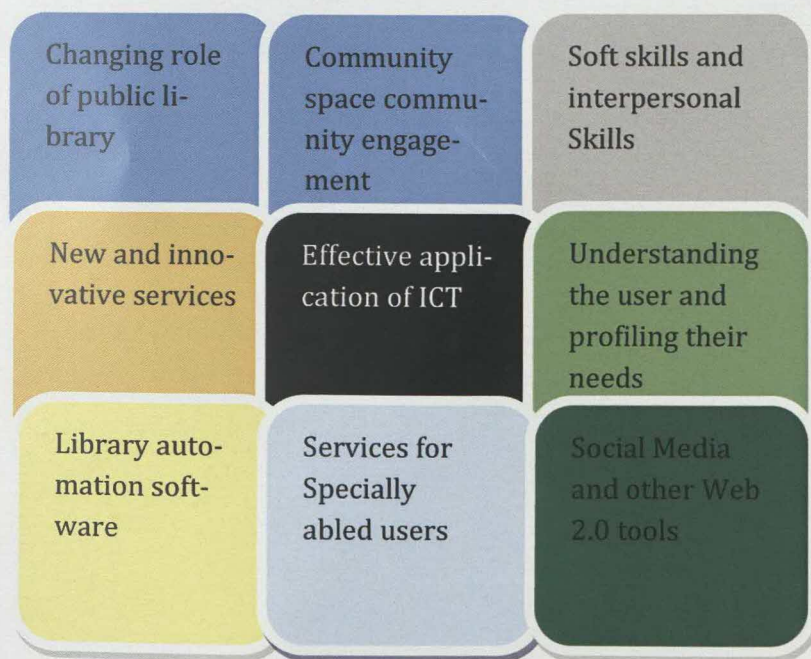


# About the Capacity Building Training Programme

One of the important components of National Mission on Libraries is Capacity Building. The country is abuzz with utilization of ICT tools in dissemination of knowledge. The present scenario has created a complex and challenging environment in which the library professionals have to function at a time when there are increasing expectations from their performance and ability to respond more efficiently and effectively to the needs of the citizens. It was felt that in order to be able to cater to the needs of librarians in diverse geographies they need to be trained as per their levels of present understanding and the future needs as librarians to fulfill their role effectively.

The changing library environment to cope with this phenomenon, NML has already taken an initiative to provide need-based training programmes for various categories of library professionals working in public and other libraries towards their capacity building and help promote upgradation of library service standards in the digital era.

Raja Rammohun Roy Library Foundation (RRRLF), the nodal agency of NML for administrative, logistic planning and budgeting purposes under the Ministry of Culture, Government of India, is entrusted to conduct these training programmes for the public library personnel throughout the country.

The **five-day** training programme would comprise of theoretical presentations and “hands-on” practical sessions eminent Library Science and IT/ Computer professionals or resource persons of the country. If feasible, the programme would include visits to important libraries of the area near by training venue.

All participants will be given **assignments / projects** individually, as well as in groups of 4 to 5, with an aim to judge their learning outcome. At the end of each programme all participants will be provided with a certificate of participation. Every participant will have the scope to provide individual **feedback** on quality or shortcomings of the programme to help RRRLF for future enhancement.
