This course will benefit interested working professionals, Indic knowledge lovers, Language Enthusiasts, Ayurveda experts and so on.

3. Certificate programme in ‘Aspects of Classical Indian Theatre’ (Online mode)

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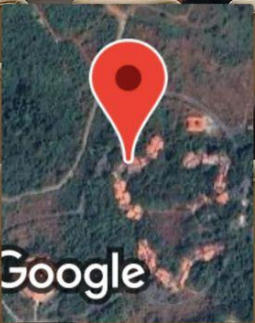
