Rules and Regulations for the Competition:

1. Eligibility: Open to all the students and teachers of Goa University. The participants must register by 10th July 5pm via the registration form.
2. Character Selection: Participants must choose a famous French personality from any field (e.g., politics, arts, science, literature). The character could be fictional too.
3. Monologue Requirements: The monologue must be original or an excerpt from a historical speech or literature, 3 to 5 minutes long, and in English.
4. Costume and Props: Dress in a costume that accurately represents your chosen personality; props are encouraged but must be manageable and safe.

General Rules:

1. Participants must arrive at the venue at least 30 minutes before the competition starts.
2. Respect and courtesy must be maintained towards all participants and organizers.
3. The organizers reserve the right to make changes to the rules and regulations if necessary.

Judging Criteria:

1. Accuracy: How well the participant represents the chosen personality.
2. Performance: Delivery, expression, and engagement with the audience.
3. Creativity: Originality and creativity in the portrayal.
4. Costume and Props: Authenticity and appropriateness of costume and props.
