9. The objectives of the Program/activity/event	Orijit Sen conducted a workshop as a part of the mapusa mogi mural project which was conceptualized by him in mapusa. He and his team had a brain storming and designing with conceptualization of the mapusa market.

Description of the Program/activity/event	Orijit Sen and his team designed a model to find solution with technology, artistic creativity ecological sensitivity and a accountment to a collective progress to break the vicious cycles and reimagine the idea of progress of the mapusa market. This was a design thinking workshop to provoke students to address defect problems and come out with solutions using design and artistic thinking to improves the situation of the mapusa market. There was 18 participants and a collection of numerous ideas, a collective model was designed.

Orijit Sen is a renowned Indian graphic artist, muralist, cartoonist, and designer, often celebrated as a pioneer of graphic novels in India. Born in Kolkata, India, Sen developed an early interest in art and storytelling, which later shaped his distinctive career. He pursued his education at the prestigious National Institute of Design (NID) in Ahmedabad, where he honed his skills in graphic design and illustration.

In 1994, Orijit Sen authored "River of Stories," widely recognized as India's first graphic novel. The novel, which explores the social and environmental impacts of the Narmada Bachao Andolan, a movement against the construction of large dams on the Narmada River, marked a turning point in Indian graphic literature. The book not only showcased Sen's artistic prowess but also his deep engagement with social and political issues, setting the tone for much of his later work.

Sen's art is characterized by its strong narrative style and intricate details, often blending traditional Indian art forms with contemporary themes. His works are not confined to the pages of books; he has created murals and public art installations across India, including the iconic mural at the Virasat-e-Khalsa museum in Punjab, which vividly depicts the history and culture of the Sikh community.

In addition to his individual work, Orijit Sen is a founding member of the Pao Collective, a group of Indian graphic artists who have played a significant role in the evolution of graphic storytelling in the country. His contributions to the field have earned him national and international acclaim, making him a key figure in the intersection of art, activism, and storytelling in India. Sen continues to influence and inspire new generations of artists and storytellers through his innovative and socially conscious work.



ABSTRACT:

This workshop will be conducted as part of the engoing activities of the Mapusa Mogi Mural Project being conceptualised by me in Mapusa. Along with a small seam of researchers and designers, I will lead the students of Gos University through a process of analysis, brainstorming, conceptualising and designing. We all know the problems that our cities are beset with. We live with them and experience them everyday-pollution, fifth, overcrowding, civic and infrastructure breakdowns... The list is long, and every 'solution' only seems to generate further problems. These repeating patterns of destruction that characterise our development paradigm today are the symptoms of failure—particularly the failure to connect the power of technology with artistic creativity, ecological sensitivity and a commitment to collective progress. But how can we break these victous cycles and re-imagine the idea of progress? How can we think about, and work towards, evolutionary goals rather then short term profit driven goals? Our 'Design Thinking' Workshop will aim to excite and provoke students to address these questions using design and artistic thinking.
