6. Detail of the Resource Person (Brief biodata)	The judges for the National Policy Hackathon competition included three experts from various fields namely Professor Debasis Patnaik. Dr. Suresh Shanbhogue and Shree Sanjeev Sardesai.
	1. Professor Debasis Patnaik. Dr Debasis Patnaik currently serves at BITS Pilani University as Professor and was past Head of the Department of Economics at Goa Campus. He has taught most of the core PG-MSc Level courses in Economics and Finance (at least 20) and Pre PhD-Courses in areas of Management, Political Economics, Engineering Economics International Finance, international Trade, Financial Geography, Research Methodology and allied Interdisciplinary areas (totaling to at least thirty courses). He was the initiator of an independent department of Economics, Management, Finance



	and Entrepreneurship in BITS Goa. Dr Patnaik has published several books which include 'Productivity, Growth and Dispersal of Indian Industry', Two Edited Books on Business and Finance Issues and Issues in Business and Finance in Emerging Markets, 'Forest Accounting' and Discovering Imperatives for Industrial Development Policy'.  2.Dr. Suresh Shanbhogue. Dr. Suresh Shanbhogue is former Director, Civil Aviation Govt of Goa. Dr. Shanbhogue has 37 years of experience in both State and Central Governments with experience in Planning & Development, Public Policy, Public Finance, Public Private Partnership, Mining, Official Statistics, Census & Surveys, and General Administration. He has published several papers. His significant contribution to administration includes Construction of Mopa Airport and Resumption of mining activity in Goa by auctioning of iron ore mineral blocks.  3.Shri Sanjeev Sardesai. A multi-faceted personality, Shri Sanjeev Sardesai is a Heritage promoter and CEO at Hands on Historians Goa and member. Goa Tourism Board. Shri Sanjeev Sardesai has held senior posts in the Hospitality industry from 1982 till 2002, ending as Group General Manager of 3 Resorts. He has held the post of Hon. - 3.To constructively utilize the innovative ideas garnered at the course of this competition to benefit key stakeholders associated with sustainable hinterland tourism in Goa
- **4.**To harness the intellect and innovative ideas of young academic minds in formulating policy documents on sustainable hinterland tourism in Goa in alignment with the Sustainable Development Goals.

#### 11. Description of the Program/activity/event

Policy Hackathon 2025 revolved around formulating policy documents (nomenclature used in the competition is policy briefs) on the theme Sustainable Hinterland Tourism in Goa: Avenues and Liabilities. The purpose of encouraging young minds to formulate policy briefs on sustainable hinterland tourism in Goa was to obtain innovative and intellectual inputs on developing and promoting sustainable hinterland tourism in Goa. The forementioned theme holds unique significance for a coastal state such as Goa which is not only blessed with a pristine coast but also enjoys the lush greens and crystal-clear waters in the hinterland. Post the critical scrutiny of policy briefs submitted by undergraduate students from national and local institutions, 10 teams were shortlisted and 7 best teams competed in the on-stage finals at Goa University. The shortlisted teams made presentations of policy briefs which they had formulated. The following are various positions secured at Policy Hackathon 2025:

- Runners up: St. Xavier's College of Arts. Science and Commerce, Mapusa-Goa
- Best Policy brief: Christ (Deemed to be University). Lavasa Campus, Pune.

- Best Speaker (Female): Anusha Anil Dhulappanavar, Christ (Deemed to be University), Lavasa Campus, Pune.

# 12. Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event

- 1. National Policy Hackathon 2025 obtained lucid written policy briefs and oral presentations on the avenues and liabilities of Sustainable Hinterland Tourism in Goa
- 2. Participants highlighted the responsibilities corroborating with the promotion of Goa as a hinterland tourism destination which



include promotion of environmental conservation, enhancing cultural preservation, empowering local communities and encouraging affordable and attractive hinterland accommodation 2. Students enunciated predictable liabilities coupled with hinterland tourism in Goa encompassing carrying capacity, socio-cultural disruptions, resource misuse and infrastructure deficiency in hinterland areas 3. Participants identified various stakeholders with whom complementary partnerships ought to be sustained to consolidate sustainable hinterland tourism in Goa. These stakeholders encompass existing and anticipated government bodies, local environmental groups, culture communities and conservation organizations and domestic and international tourists and travellers. 4. 
