11. Description of the Program/activity/event	<p>The two-day placement constituted two components:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Orientation and Grammar test: The initial session included an orientation about the nature of the positions available at the newspaper followed by an Objective grammar test to evaluate their command over English language usage, accuracy, and editing skills. 2. The grammar test was followed by a written test that assessed their ability to write clearly, concisely, and creatively. It aimed at evaluating the candidates' writing style, coherence, and journalistic aptitude. <p>The placement process was tailored to align with the academic strengths of MA English students and provide them with a platform to launch a rewarding career in the media and publishing industry.</p>

Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event	The placement provided employment and networking opportunities, industry exposure, assessed their language skills and boosted their professional confidence. A permanent desk position and freelance positions with internships were offered to all participating students.
