10. The objectives of the Program/activity/event	The program was organized to celebrate the legacy of Louis Pasteur, a pioneer in microbiology, and to inspire budding microbiologists. Through an insightful talk by Mrs. Vatsala Sukthankar and a scientific poster competition on processes in industrial microbiology, the event encouraged students to explore, innovate, and connect with the scientific community.

Description of the Program/activity/event	The activity was organized by the Marine Microbiology Program, School of Earth, Ocean, and Atmospheric Sciences (SEOAS), in collaboration with the Microbiologist's Society, India (MBSI), to commemorate the birth anniversary of Louis Pasteur, a pioneer in microbiology. The event was attended by 50 participants and was graced by the presence of Vice Dean (Academics), Dr. A. Veigas. The Program Director of Marine Microbiology addressed the gathering, emphasizing the importance of such events in recognizing the invaluable contributions of microbiologists. M.Sc. Part II student, Mr. Franzil Fernandes, spoke on the contributions of Louis Pasteur, highlighting his groundbreaking impact on the field of microbiology. Ms. Susanna Sampiyo introduced the invited speaker, Ms. Vatsala Sukthankar. The keynote talk by Ms. Sukthankar was a major highlight of the program. She delivered an insightful lecture on the role of microbiological techniques employed in the pharmaceutical industry. She also shared guidance on prerequisites for aspiring students and recounted her inspiring journey to becoming a consultant microbiologist at a young age. The event featured a poster competition on the theme <i>Processes in Industrial Microbiology</i> . The program concluded with a prize distribution ceremony, where the third prize was awarded to Ms. Sana Khan, the second prize to Ms. Lesha Lotlikar, and the first prize to Mr. Aditya Shrivastava of M.Sc. Part I. The vote of thanks was proposed by Ms. Ruksar Alam, and the event was hosted by Mr. Agnelo Sequeira.
