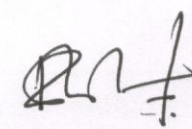

10. Description of the Program/activity/event	Prof. Ved Prakash, former Chairman of UGC and Former Vice Chancellor of National Institute of Educational Planning &

	Administration, New Delhi, delivered an insightful talk on Global Trends in Higher Education. The talk emphasized the importance of internationalization of higher education, including student and faculty mobility, collaborations, and curriculum development. Prof. Ved Prakash stressed on the need for higher education institutions to ensure quality and relevance in their programs, aligning them with the needs of the global marketplace. He discussed the challenges facing higher education in India, including access, equity, and the need for reforms to improve the system.
