Description of the Program/activity/event	<p>The Annual General Body Meeting of the Goa University Alumni Association (GUAA) was convened on 21st June 2025 at 3:00 PM in the Conference Hall of Goa University. The meeting brought together members of the academic and alumni community to review the Association's progress, assess its financial performance, and deliberate on strategic initiatives to enhance alumni engagement and support the University's mission.</p> <p>The meeting commenced with a welcome address by Dr. Arvind Haldankar, who outlined the agenda for the day. This was followed by remarks from the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Harilal B. Menon, who underscored the vital role of alumni in the University's sustained growth and development.</p> <p>A key highlight of the meeting was the presentation of the audited financial statements for the year 2024–25 by Dr. Harip Kanapuri. The report reflected noteworthy contributions from alumni and reaffirmed GUAA's commitment to student welfare through scholarships and related initiatives.</p> <p>The meeting also addressed the forthcoming renewal of the Association's registration, an essential step for maintaining legal continuity and fulfilling NAAC accreditation requirements.</p> <p>Several strategic proposals were discussed to further strengthen alumni engagement,</p>
