10. The objectives of the Program/activity/event	The objectives of this program were to enable the participants to develop Effective Communication Skills, to strengthen leadership competencies, foster team collaboration, boost presentation skills, and encourage strategic thinking.	
11. Description of the Program/activity/event	The workshop on "Empowerment through Soft Skills: Leadership and Communication Excellence" was organized with the aim of enhancing participants' interpersonal and leadership capabilities through a highly interactive and engaging format. The session was facilitated by Mr. Elton Fernandes, a dynamic resource person known for his expertise in soft skills training and youth empowerment. Mr. Fernandes was warmly welcomed and invited to conduct the workshop, setting the tone with a series of ice-breakers and energizing games that immediately captured	

the participants' interest and created an open, collaborative environment. Each activity was thoughtfully designed to highlight specific learning outcomes related to creativity, leadership development, and effective communication.

Throughout the session, participants engaged in team-based tasks, role-plays, and group discussions, each followed by reflective insights shared by the resource person to reinforce the key takeaways. A particularly memorable segment of the workshop involved students forming their own groups and composing rhyming lines about university. This creative exercise was met with great enthusiasm, and the students impressed everyone with their thoughtful and poetic reflections, demonstrating not only their linguistic flair but also their pride and affection for their institution. The workshop encouraged participants to step out of their comfort zones, express themselves confidently, and understand the dynamics of leading with empathy and purpose. The Participants were thoroughly enthused with this workshop with requests to organize more such workshops for their benefit.

12. Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event

The workshop on "Empowerment through Soft Skills: Leadership and Communication Excellence" provided numerous benefits to the participants. One of the most significant outcomes was the enhancement communication skills—students learned to articulate their thoughts more clearly and confidently, both verbally and non-verbally. The interactive format also allowed them to explore and strengthen core leadership traits such as decision-making, motivation, and teamwork. Creative exercises, including group poetry writing, fostered innovative thinking and encouraged students to step out of their comfort zones.

Collaboration was a key theme throughout the session, as students engaged in group activities that built mutual respect, active listening, and cooperation. These experiences, in turn, boosted their self-confidence and helped many overcome inhibitions related to public speaking and group interaction. The

	workshop also promoted emotional intelligence by emphasizing empathy, self-awareness, and understanding others—essential qualities for effective leadership and interpersonal relationships. By interacting with peers in a structured, supportive environment, students gained valuable insights from diverse perspectives and developed stronger social connections. The practical nature of the activities ensured that learning was experiential and immediately applicable. Notably, the creative task of composing rhyming lines about the university allowed students to express institutional pride in a fun and meaningful way. Overall, the workshop laid a strong foundation for career readiness, equipping students with the soft skills needed to succeed in academic, professional, and personal spheres.


University Life




