Admission to joint certificate course on “New Challenges to International Justice and International Arbitration” 2025-26

Applications are invited for admission to the Certificate Course in “**New Challenges to International Justice and International Arbitration**” to be offered at the Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance & Public Policy, Goa University for Academic Year 2025-26, **jointly conducted by Goa University and the Faculty of Law, University of Lisbon (FDUL)**.

### **Objectives of the course are as follows:**

The proposed certificate course and the collaboration delivery of the Generic Elective by distinguished international faculty aim to:

1. To expand access to advanced legal education for local students and professionals through a high-impact, globally benchmarked certificate programme.
2. To align with NEP 2020 goals by promoting flexible, interdisciplinary, and international modes of learning that reflect the evolving needs of higher education.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

Individuals currently pursuing, or having completed, an undergraduate qualifying Degree in any discipline from a recognized University.

#### **I. Goa University (On Campus) Participants:**

Students of Goa University (On Campus) who are enrolled in the Generic Elective course LLA 624: New Challenges to International Justice and International Arbitration are not required to register separately for the Joint Certificate Course. However, they may attend the tutorial sessions and will be eligible to receive a certificate of participation from FDUL only, subject to attendance and completion of requirements. Such students are not required to pay Fees.

#### **II. Other Participants:**

Individuals who are enrolled in the LL.M. programme or other programmes at affiliated Colleges or general public may register for the Joint Certificate Course as other participants.

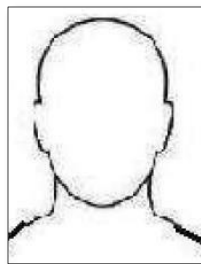
**Fees for the Programme:** INR 5,120 (applicable to other participants)

  - iii. **The face must take up 70-80% of the photo.**

  - Reservation category certificate - SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwD. (PDF format)
  - Declaration of Only Girl Child. (PDF/JPEG/JPG) on plain A4 size paper only. (Refer ANNEXURE I)
